

NOTICE OF VACANCY

BOARD OF DIRECTORS – MOJAVE DESERT RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT

The Mojave Desert Resource Conservation District has accepted the resignation of Earl Graham, a member of the District's Board of Directors. As provided in Section 9316 of the California Public Resources Code, in case of a vacancy in the office of director appointed pursuant to Section 9314, the vacancy shall be filled, as provided in Section 9314, by appointment for the unexpired term by the Board of Supervisors of the principal County. Mr. Graham was appointed pursuant to Section 9314 on September 23, 2025 for the remaining four-year term, expiring November 24, 2028.

The Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County will appoint a member to the Board of Directors to fill the unexpired term. QUALIFICATIONS: A member of the Board of Directors of a resource conservation district must be a registered voter in the state, and (1) reside within the district comprised generally of the desert portions of San Bernardino County and either own real property in the district or have served for two years or more as an associate director providing advisory or other assistance to the district directors, or (2) be a designated agent of a resident landowner within the district. A member should have a demonstrated interest in soil and water conservation.
