

POST-EVENT MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY AND _____ FOR
ASSISTANCE UNDER THE LAW ENFORCEMENT MUTUAL AID PLAN

This Post-Event Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is made and entered into by and between San Bernardino County (County) and the _____.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on _____, 20XX, a enter type of event here (i.e. flood, fire, mudslide, etc.), known as the Enter event's name and general description/information here (i.e., size of area affected, community(ies), number of home/residents affected, other pertinent information); and

WHEREAS, on *Month Day*, 20XX, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved emergency assistance through a *Fire/Flood* Management Action Grant (FMXXXX-CA); and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Plan is issued and revised under the authority of Government Code sections 8550, 8569, 8615–8619, and 8668, the California Emergency Plan, and the Master Mutual Aid Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Plan delineates the current State policy concerning law enforcement mutual aid; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Plan describes the standard procedures used to acquire law enforcement mutual aid resources and the method to ensure coordination of law enforcement mutual aid planning and readiness; and

WHEREAS, the County's Sheriff/Coroner/Public Administrator (Sheriff) is the Operational Area Law Enforcement and Mutual Aid Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Plan provides, in pertinent part, "When an emergency develops or appears to be developing which cannot be resolved by a law enforcement agency within an Operational Area, it is the responsibility of the Operational Area Mutual Aid Coordinator to provide assistance and coordination to control the problem;" and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Plan provides, in pertinent part, "A request for law enforcement mutual aid requires the approval of the chief law enforcement officer of the requesting jurisdiction;" and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requested the mutual aid assistance of the _____, pursuant to the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Plan to support law enforcement services in connection with the enter event's name here; and

WHEREAS, the _____ provided mutual aid assistance consisting of law enforcement personnel, equipment, and materials from Month day, 20XX through Month day, 20XX, to assist

with law enforcement services in connection with the Name of event here; and

WHEREAS, the _____ agreed to document all of its mutual aid assistance costs related to the enter event's name here, as attachments to this MOA, and submit them to the County as soon as possible upon execution of this MOA;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the _____ and San Bernardino County that, to the extent that the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Plan does not otherwise reimburse the _____, the County may reimburse reasonable costs incurred by the _____ that were associated with it's provision of law enforcement mutual aid assistance to the County during the enter event's name here.

This MOA, and if applicable, any subsequent amendments, may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same MOA. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this MOA (whether by facsimile, PDF or other mail transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed MOA upon request.
