

ORDINANCE NO. SD 22-____

An ordinance of Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District to establish various recreation and park activity fees for Fiscal Year 2022-23 and to repeal Ordinance No. SD 20-04.

The Board of Directors of the Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District, County of San Bernardino, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 2022, Ordinance No. SD 20-04 is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2022, the Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District recreation and park activity fees and charges shall hereby be established as follows:

3 **17.** The Director of the Department of Public Works is authorized to establish and
4 charge fees pertaining to recreational activities and day care services, provided that
5 these fees do not exceed the reasonable costs of providing the services or that these
6 fees otherwise comply with the law. A list of these fees is on the Department's website.

7 **18. Fee Deferral, Waiver, or Refund.** This subsection is effective the date that this
8 ordinance is effective. In the event of a disaster, or other good cause shown to serve a
9 public purpose, the Director of Department of Public Works may defer payment of,
10 waive, or refund any fee set forth in this chapter provided all of the following conditions
11 are met:

12 (a) Exigent conditions exist whereby obtaining Board approval of the fee
13 waiver/refund/deferral would not be immediately feasible; and

14 (b) The Director of Department of Public Works receives concurrence from
15 the County Chief Executive Officer.

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17 SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the date of
18 adoption.
