AMENDMENT NO. 3

It is hereby agreed to amend Contract No. 19-348 as follows:

SECTION V. FISCAL PROVISIONS

Amend Section V., Paragraph B. to read as follows:

As of November 30, 2024, County shall reimburse Contractor for costs associated with the performance of the SSI Legal Advocacy Service on a case-by-case basis at a rate not to exceed whichever is less of \$9,200 or twenty-five percent (25%), of the retroactive SSI/SSP benefits for SSI approvals. There will be no charge for those cases not approved for SSI/SSP, except for reimbursement of fees for medical records per Paragraph C of this Section.

SECTION VIII. TERM

Amend Section VIII. to read as follows:

This Contract is effective as of July 1, 2019, and is extended from the expiration date of September 30, 2024 to expire on March 31, 2025, but may be terminated earlier in accordance with provisions of Section IX of the Contract. The disposition of pending appeals, if any, shall be determined upon Contract termination.

DEFINITIONS

Otherwise related entity: An otherwise related entity is any for-profit organization/company which does not have a parent-subsidiary relationship but meets one of the following criteria:

- (1) One business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other business entity;
- (2) there is shared management and control between the entities; or
- (3) a controlling owner (50% or greater interest as a shareholder or as a general partner) in one entity also is a controlling owner in the other entity.

For purposes of (2), "shared management and control" can be found when the same person or substantially the same persons own and manage the two entities; there are common or commingled funds or assets; the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share activities, resources or personnel on a regular basis; or there is otherwise a regular and close working relationship between the entities.
