Executive Summary (2500 max characters) The Arrowhead Regional Medical Center (ARMC) Primary Care Track is requesting funding for two existing resident positions and three expanding positions for Internal Medicine to support its effort to increase primary care physicians in the underserved regions of San Bernardino County of California. Our mission is to train racially and ethnically diverse internal medicine residents who are competent and culturally sensitive and who desire to practice in underserved areas after completing residency. San Bernardino County ranks in the bottom tier of counties in California for patient to primary care physician ratio and ranks in the lowest 15 for overall health outcomes. ARMC has set goals to develop expertise in our residents related to health disparities, advocacy and population health to improve population level outcomes in both of these metrics.

Internal Medicine residents complete their residency training in San Bernardino County at ARMC. The Continuity Clinic is onsite at ARMC with the majority of the patient population being Hispanic or Latino and over 81 percent of the patients seen in the Continuity Clinic have Medi-Cal or managed care Medi-Cal.

In their time at ARMC residents are exceptionally trained in their ACGME mandatory sub-specialty rotations with the goal of being competent to practice Internal Medicine in areas of physician shortages without tertiary care centers. Residents are exposed to low income patients in the inpatient and outpatient setting and learn about the difficulties many individuals face with complex care needs and very limited resources. At ARMC, our residents work in interdisciplinary teams to address the cultural, social or economic barriers our patients experience.

The ARMC Internal Medicine Program participates in teaching medical students from Loma Linda University Health, Saint Georges University, Western University, California University of Science and Medicine (CUSM), and University of California-Riverside Medical School (UCR). We will be graduating our 2021 class of 12 residents and currently have a full complement of 36 residents. Beginning in 2021, the program will be expanding to 16 residents per year. Additionally, CUSM is now located on the ARMC campus. CUSM has a focus on targeting low-income, minority individuals coming from the region to enroll as students.

Internal Medicine residents work with PAs and NPs in their continuity clinic and take care of patients as a team. Mid-level health care professionals also cover non-teaching medicine teams and as a result they collaborate closely with structures training that encourages graduates to practice as a health care team that includes licensed and non-physician practitioners. Medicine department mid-level professionals participate and contribute to our residents' didactic sessions. This provides an opportunity for all medical professionals to provide care for their patients that is evidence based and collaborative.

Step 5

What training program components prepare primary care residents to address community behavioral health needs? (2500 max characters)

The Internal Medicine program uses a variety of methods to prepare our residents to address the behavioral health needs of our patients. First, we utilize a core curriculum developed by Yale University, which includes lectures covering behavioral health topics. Next, our residents utilize screening tools in our clinic visits such as PHQ-9, GAD-7, and AUDIT. Finally, we teach our residents to use the SBIRT and subsequently providing medication management. We have the ability to treat Opioid Use Disorder with Suboxone and Vivitrol for alcohol use disorder.

How does the residency program address the behavioral health needs of the patients they serve? (2500 max characters)

The Internal Medicine program addresses the behavioral health needs of our patients in multiple ways. First, we provide medication assisted treatment such as suboxone for opioid use disorder, oral and injectable naltrexone for alcohol use disorder. Next, we have access to the SHAPE team which consists of a social worker, community health worker, physician, nurse, and medical assistant to help higher risk patients with mental health conditions get connected with resources. They also bring up to providers when patients are having a hard time. Patients in this program undergo regular screening for their mental health condition to ensure it is being tracked/improving. If a decompensation is noted, an appointment with the provider is made to address worsening and provide appropriate referral. Additionally, the Medical Center is launching a Whole Person Care Program into the resident clinic to help smooth the transition from inpatient to outpatient. This program will allow residents to refer their patients for closer follow up with a community-based team (social worker etc.) to ensure patients get to their appointments/follow through with care. Next, the program utilizes toolkits specific to the Inland Empire to help provide patient resources. Finally, our program faculty participate in a behavioral health integration team to create a more seamless communication between outpatient behavioral health care and the outpatient clinic.
