IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

**AMENDMENT NO. 2
CONTRACT NO. 21-668
CUSTODIAL SERVICES CONTRACT**

This Amendment No. 2 (Amendment) dated March 26, 2024 is made by and between Santa Fe Janitorial Maintenance Services, Inc. (Contractor) and San Bernardino County (County) for custodial services and modifies the terms to Contract No. 21-668, executed between the parties and effective as of November 1, 2021 (Contract).

WHEREAS, the County conducted a competitive process to find Contractor to provide custodial maintenance services (Services), and

WHEREAS, based upon and in reliance on the representations of Contractor in its response to the County's Request for Proposals, the County found Contractor qualified to provide these Services; and

WHEREAS, the County desired that such Services be provided by Contractor and Contractor agreed to perform these services as set forth below; and

WHEREAS, on 9-14-21 (Item No. 43), the Board of Supervisors approved Contract No. 21-668 for these Services; and

WHEREAS, on 2-8-22 (Item No. 49), the Board of Supervisors approved Contract No. 21-668 A-1 to change Contractor's legal corporate name to Santa Fe Janitorial Maintenance Services Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and Contractor mutually agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. **REPLACE Section F.1. Fiscal Provisions** with the following: The County will compensate the Contractor for its services under this Contract \$56,719 monthly (effective 4/1/2024), one month in arrears. Contractor will only be compensated for emergency related work performed following receipt of written or email authorization from the Project & Facilities Management Department, approving the work and the estimate provided by Contractor. Contractor shall include the written or email authorization with any email provided by Contractor. The maximum amount of payment under this Contract shall not exceed **\$3,984,290** and shall be subject to availability of funds to the County. The consideration to be paid to Contractor, as provided herein, shall be in full payment for all Contractor's services and expenses incurred in the performance hereof, including travel and per diem.

2. **ADD Section C. 49 Political Contributions** as follows:
Contractor has disclosed to the County using Attachment C, whether it has made any campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector and the District Attorney] within the earlier of: (1) the date of the submission of Contractor's proposal to the County, or (2) 12 months before the date this Contract was approved by the Board of Supervisors. Contractor acknowledges that under Government Code section 84308, Contractor is prohibited from making campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer for 12 months after the County's consideration of the Contract.

In the event of a proposed amendment to this Contract, the Contractor will provide the County a written statement disclosing any campaign contribution(s) of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer within the preceding 12 months of the date of the proposed amendment.

Campaign contributions include those made by any agent/person/entity on behalf of the Contractor or by a parent, subsidiary or otherwise related business entity of Contractor

3. **REPLACE ATTACHMENT B, COST PER SITE, with ATTACHMENT B** included in this Amendment.
4. **ADD ATTACHMENT C, SENATE BILL 1439, CONTRACTOR INFORMATION REPORT**, attached hereto and incorporated herein.
5. **CAPITALIZED TERMS**
Any capitalized term used, but not defined, in this Amendment shall have the meaning given to it in the Contract.
6. **FULL FORCE AND EFFECT**
The Contract, as modified by this Amendment, remains in full force and effect.
7. **CONTRACT EXECUTION**
This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same Amendment. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Amendment (whether by facsimile, PDF or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein.

Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Amendment upon request.

ATTACHMENT C

Campaign Contribution Disclosure (Senate Bill 1439)

DEFINITIONS

Actively supporting the matter: (a) Communicate directly with a member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, District Attorney, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector] for the purpose of influencing the decision on the matter; or (b) testifies or makes an oral statement before the County in a proceeding on the matter for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (c) communicates with County employees, for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (d) when the person/company's agent lobbies in person, testifies in person or otherwise communicates with the Board or County employees for purposes of influencing the County's decision in a matter.

Agent: A third-party individual or firm who, for compensation, is representing a party or a participant in the matter submitted to the Board of Supervisors. If an agent is an employee or member of a third-party law, architectural, engineering or consulting firm, or a similar entity, both the entity and the individual are considered agents.

Otherwise related entity: An otherwise related entity is any for-profit organization/company which does not have a parent-subsidary relationship but meets one of the following criteria:

- (1) One business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other business entity;
- (2) there is shared management and control between the entities; or
- (3) a controlling owner (50% or greater interest as a shareholder or as a general partner) in one entity also is a controlling owner in the other entity.

For purposes of (2), "shared management and control" can be found when the same person or substantially the same persons own and manage the two entities; there are common or commingled funds or assets; the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share activities, resources, or personnel on a regular basis; or there is otherwise a regular and close working relationship between the entities.

Parent-Subsidiary Relationship: A parent-subsidiary relationship exists when one corporation has more than 50 percent of the voting power of another corporation.
