#### Amendment No. 1

### IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

Effective August 9, 2023, Contract No. 22-427 is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. **SECTION B. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES,** Paragraph B.1.2 is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - B.1.2 Provide housing for adult males (ages 18 and older), adult pregnant females (ages 18 and older), and adult females (ages 18 and older) with child/children (12 and under). This includes offenders that have been diagnosed with mental health disorder and/or substance use disorder. Contractor cannot accept sex offenders, or offenders convicted of arson. Contractor can house Choosing Health Options to Instill Changes and Empowerment (CHOICE) offenders. The offenders housed in the facility will be under supervision for their last offense(s), which can include supervision under Pretrial, Probation, Mandatory Supervision and/or Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS) for a variety of felony offenses.

2. SECTION C. GENERAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS, Paragraph C.51 is hereby added to the Contract to read as follows:

## C.51 Campaign Contribution Disclosure (SB 1439)

Contractor has disclosed to the County using Attachment B - Campaign Contribution Disclosure Senate Bill 1439, whether it has made any campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector and the District Attorney] within the earlier of: (1) the date of the submission of Contractor's proposal to the County, or (2) 12 months before the date this Contract was approved by the Board of Supervisors. Contractor acknowledges that under Government Code section 84308, Contractor is prohibited from making campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer for 12 months after the County's consideration of the Contract.

In the event of a proposed amendment to this Contract, the Contractor will provide the County a written statement disclosing any campaign contribution(s) of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer within the preceding 12 months of the date of the proposed amendment.

Campaign contributions include those made by any agent/person/entity on behalf of the Contractor or by a parent, subsidiary or otherwise related business entity of Contractor.

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# ATTACHMENT B Campaign Contribution Disclosure (SB 1439)

#### **DEFINITIONS**

Actively supporting the matter: (a) Communicate directly, either in person or in writing, with a member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, District Attorney, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector] with the purpose of influencing the decision on the matter; or (b) testifies or makes an oral statement before the County in a proceeding on the matter; or (c) communicates with County employees, for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (d) when the person/company's agent lobbies in person, testifies in person or otherwise communicates with the Board or County employees for purposes of influencing the County's decision in a matter.

<u>Agent:</u> A third-party individual or firm who is representing a party or a participant in the matter submitted to the Board of Supervisors. If an agent is an employee or member of a third-party law, architectural, engineering or consulting firm, or a similar entity, both the entity and the individual are considered agents.

Otherwise related entity: An otherwise related entity is any for-profit organization/company which does not have a parent-subsidiary relationship but meets one of the following criteria:

- (1) One business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other business entity;
- (2) there is shared management and control between the entities; or
- (3) a controlling owner (50% or greater interest as a shareholder or as a general partner) in one entity also is a controlling owner in the other entity.

For purposes of (2), "shared management and control" can be found when the same person or substantially the same persons own and manage the two entities; there are common or commingled funds or assets; the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share activities, resources or personnel on a regular basis; or there is otherwise a regular and close working relationship between the entities.

<u>Parent-Subsidiary Relationship:</u> A parent-subsidiary relationship exists when one corporation has more than 50 percent of the voting power of another corporation.
