RECOMMENDATION(S)

- Approve Agreement 24-755 (State Contract No. 23-0083) with the California Department of Health Care Services to receive supplemental payments for Medi-Cal managed care capitation rate increases, and for the provision of an intergovernmental transfer assessment fee for administration of the intergovernmental transfer program during the term of the Stateestablished claim period of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, for the Agreement term of January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2026.
- 2. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to maintain confidentiality of the Agreement pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 1457(c)(1).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this item will not result in the use of Discretionary General Funding (Net County Cost). Agreements are sent annually from the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), requesting claims from the prior year. Under the terms of the agreement, Arrowhead Regional Medical Center (ARMC) will be eligible to receive supplemental payments as the result of Medi-Cal managed care capitation rate increases paid to Molina Healthcare of California, Inc. (Molina) and Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) as managed care providers for the claim period of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

The non-federal share for Intergovernmental Transfers (IGTs) will be remitted from the County's Health Administration budget unit. Once the funds are received by ARMC from Molina and IEHP, ARMC will transfer funds equal to the amount remitted into the County's Health Administration budget unit. Adequate appropriation and revenue have been included in the ARMC and Health Administration 2024-25 budget and will be included in future recommended budgets.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Agreement with the California Department of Health Care Services for Intergovernmental Transfer Program August 20, 2024

The agreement with DHCS will allow ARMC to continue participation in the IGT program and receive funding (including Medi-Cal managed care capitation rate payments) for Medi-Cal patients enrolled with IEHP and Molina. To participate in the IGT program, the State requires that an agreement be in place for the IGT of public funds.

The agreement with DHCS allows ARMC to receive supplemental payments resulting from Medi-Cal managed care capitation rate increases for enrolled patients. The agreement sets forth the conditions for the transfer and receipt of funds through the DHCS IGT program.

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 1457(c)(1) specific terms related to the rates of payment for health care services are not immediately subject to laws related to public records; therefore, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is directed to maintain confidentiality of this agreement.

ARMC recommends approval of the agreement as it will allow ARMC to operate in a fiscally-responsible and business-like manner by working with the State to obtain reimbursements for the healthcare services it renders to certain County residents who are members of IEHP and Molina.
