THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 is entered into in the State of California by and between San Bernardino County, hereinafter called the County, and SAS Institute Inc. referenced above, hereinafter called Contractor.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

WITNESSETH:

IN THAT CERTAIN **Contract No. 20-1173** by and between San Bernardino County, a political subdivision of the State of California, and Contractor for data warehousing mining, software maintenance and support services which Contract first became effective November 3, 2019, the following changes are hereby made and agreed to, effective date of execution:

- I. ARTICLE IX <u>PERSONNEL</u>, paragraph B, is hereby amended and paragraphs D and E, are hereby added to read as follows:
 - B. Iran Contracting Act

IRAN CONTRACTING ACT OF 2010, Public Contract Code sections 2200 et seq. (Applicable for all Contracts of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or more). In accordance with Public Contract Code section 2204(a), the Contractor certifies that at the time the Contract is signed, the Contractor signing the Contract is not identified on a list created pursuant to subdivision (b)

of Public Contract Code section 2203 as a person (as defined in Public Contract Code section 2202(e)) engaging in investment activities in Iran described in subdivision (a) of Public Contract Code section 2202.5, or as a person described in subdivision (b) of Public Contract Code section 2202.5, as applicable.

Contractors are cautioned that making a false certification may subject the Contractor to civil penalties, termination of existing contract, and ineligibility to bid on a contract for a period of three (3) years in accordance with Public Contract Code section 2205.

D. Executive Order N-6-22 Russia Sanctions

On March 4, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-6-22 (the EO) regarding Economic Sanctions against Russia and Russian entities and individuals. "Economic Sanctions" refers to sanctions imposed by the U.S. government in response to Russia's actions in Ukraine (https://home.treasury.gov/policy-issues/financial-sanctions/sanctions-programs-and-country-information/ukraine-russia-related-sanctions), as well as any sanctions imposed under state law (https://www.dgs.ca.gov/OLS/Ukraine-Russia). The EO directs state agencies and their contractors (including by agreement or receipt of a grant) to terminate contracts with, and to refrain from entering any new contracts with, individuals or entities that are determined to be a target of Economic Sanctions. Accordingly, should it be determined that Contractor is a target of Economic Sanctions or is conducting prohibited transactions with sanctioned individuals or entities, that shall be grounds for termination of this agreement. Contractor shall be provided advance written notice of such termination, allowing Contractor at least 30 calendar days to provide a written response. Termination shall be at the sole discretion of the County.

E. Campaign Contribution Disclosure (SB 1439)

Contractor has disclosed to the County using Attachment III - Campaign Contribution Disclosure Senate Bill 1439, whether it has made any campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector and the District Attorney] within the earlier of: (1) the date of the submission of Contractor's proposal to the County, or (2) 12 months before the date this Contract was approved by the Board of Supervisors. Contractor acknowledges that under Government Code section 84308, Contractor is prohibited from making campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer for 12 months after the County's consideration of the Contract.

In the event of a proposed amendment to this Contract, the Contractor will provide the County a written statement disclosing any campaign contribution(s) of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer within the preceding 12 months of the date of the proposed amendment.

Campaign contributions include those made by any agent/person/entity on behalf of the Contractor or by a parent, subsidiary or otherwise related business entity of Contractor.

- II. ADDENDUM III "SUPPLEMENT to the MASTER LICENSE AGREEMEMNT", SUPPLEMENT GRID, "SAS DataPack for US Address Verification" has been removed and is hereby amended to read "SAS Data Management DataPack US Address Verification."
- III. ADDENDUM III "SUPPLEMENT to the MASTER LICENSE AGREEMEMNT", SUPPLEMENT GRID, the column marked "Applicable Pricing Metric, Number of Authorized Units" on the Software grid reference to "DataPack Site License" has been removed and is hereby amended to read "DataPack Installs."

- IV. ADDENDUM III "SUPPLEMENT to the MASTER LICENSE AGREEMEMNT", Section 3.1.6 "ENRICHMENT DATA USE TERMS", has been removed and is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 3.1.6 Enrichment Data Use Terms All data necessary to use the Software is subject to the Enrichment Data Use Terms available at https://www.sas.com/enrichment.
- V. ADDENDUM III "SUPPLEMENT to the MASTER LICENSE AGREEMEMNT", Section 3.1.8 "DATAPACK SITE LICENSE" has been removed and is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 3.1.8 DataPack Installs The Fee is based on the number of DataPack Installs where a "DataPack Install" is defined as the installation of the Software in a single Authorized Environment for production use. Customer's use of the Software is dependent upon Customer's licensing, under the Agreement, certain other SAS software ("Required Software").
- VI. ATTACHMENT III "CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE (SB1439)", is hereby added.

VII.	All other terms.	conditions and	covenants in	the basic agreement	remain in full force	and effect.

This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same Amendment. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Amendment (whether by facsimile, PDF or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Amendment upon request.

DEFINITIONS

Actively supporting the matter: (a) Communicate directly with a member of the Board of Supervisors or other County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor-Recorder-Clerk, District Attorney, Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector] for the purpose of influencing the decision on the matter; or (b) testifies or makes an oral statement before the County in a proceeding on the matter for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (c) communicates with County employees, for the purpose of influencing the County's decision on the matter; or (d) when the person/company's agent lobbies in person, testifies in person or otherwise communicates with the Board or County employees for purposes of influencing the County's decision in a matter.

Otherwise related entity: An otherwise related entity is any for-profit organization/company which does not have a parent-subsidiary relationship but meets one of the following criteria:

- One business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other business entity;
- (2) there is shared management and control between the entities; or
- (3) a controlling owner (50% or greater interest as a shareholder or as a general partner) in one entity also is a controlling owner in the other entity.

For purposes of (2), "shared management and control" can be found when the same person or substantially the same persons own and manage the two entities; there are common or commingled funds or assets; the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share activities, resources, or personnel on a regular basis; or there is otherwise a regular and close working relationship between the entities.

<u>Parent-Subsidiary Relationship:</u> A parent-subsidiary relationship exists when one corporation has more than 50 percent of the voting power of another corporation.
