

Project Summary

Cucamonga Guasti Regional Park provides 150 acres of outdoor recreation activities in an urban setting. There is a wide range of activities including two lakes for fishing, splash pad, picnic tables and group picnic shelters for corporate events, large parties and family reunions.

The primary goal of this project encompasses the replacement of the deteriorating boat dock at Cucamonga-Guasti Regional Park, due to the adverse effects of inclement weather and extended usage over the years. The current state of the dock renders it inaccessible and unusable, posing both safety concerns and operational challenges. To mitigate these issues, the proposed solution is to install a new aluminum dock that not only addresses structural deficiencies but also ensures resilience against weather-related deterioration.

Additionally, the replacement dock will be designed and constructed in compliance per accessibility standards or requirements, enhancing accessibility for all park visitors. This includes the incorporation of ramps, handrails, and other accessibility features, guaranteeing that individuals with disabilities can enjoy the waterfront experience at Guasti Regional Park. The successful completion of this project is expected to contribute to increased park usage and park patron enjoyment.
