Operational Agreement

This Operational Agreement stands as evidence that the **San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office** and **Partners Against Violence/Crime Survivor Services** intend to work together toward the mutual goal of providing maximum available assistance for crime victims residing in San Bernardino County through the Victim/Witness (VW) Assistance Program in San Bernardino County.

Each participating agency believes that implementation of the Victim/Witness (VW) Assistance Program, as described herein, will further this goal. To this end, each agency agrees to participate in the program, if funded and implemented, by coordinating and providing services outlined herein.

Program Background

The District Attorney's Victim/Witness (VW) Assistance Program provides mandatory services under PC 13835.5 to victims of all crime types. The services include: crisis intervention, emergency assistance, resource and referral assistance, emotional support, victim of crime claim assistance, property return, orientation to the criminal justice system, court escort, case status/disposition, notification of family and friends, employer notification/intervention and restitution assistance. Presentations and training for criminal justice agencies and public presentations are also mandated services through this program.

Roles

The **San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office** the **Victim/Witness (VW) Assistance Program** will coordinate and provide the following services:

- Coordinate services and provide referrals and emergency assistance to crime victims of the Victim/Witness (VW) Assistance Program cases
- Assist victims by providing the California Victim Compensation Board (Cal VCB) program application and assisting them through the application process
- Provide to crime victims an orientation to the criminal justice system, case status and disposition, court escort and court support, and restitution assistance
- Provide training to staff on a regular basis and that said training will be expanded to include all components of the program
- Participation in meetings as needed to discuss issues of interagency coordination and information to ensure appropriate delivery of services for victims of the Victim/Witness (VW) Assistance Program cases.

Partners Against Violence/Crime Survivor Services will coordinate the following services:

- Refer victims to the **San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office** for the services provided above
- Refer to the **San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office** survivors of violent crimes to obtain information and assist with completing and filing the California Victim Compensation Board program application, explaining the procedure, obtaining required documentation and tracking information related to the claim

- Refer to the **San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office** survivors of violent crimes to assist in understanding and participation in the criminal justice system/judicial proceedings
- Provide the following services to survivors of violent crimes: 24-hour crisis intervention hotline and on-site response, advocacy and accompaniment to local hospitals, law enforcement interviews and legal proceedings, individual and group counseling, education and prevention programs and community referrals

Term


This agreement will be effective beginning July 1, 2024, through December 31, 2027, or until otherwise modified by written consent of all involved parties.


