SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4385

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regularly scheduled meeting on 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 19, 2020, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance for the repeal and reenact Division 6 of Title 4 of the San Bernardino Code relating to Solid Waste Handling Franchises.

Ordinance Summary

The ordinance modifies the Code to add and update definitions, update references to defined terms throughout the Code, and add a commercial solid waste and organic waste recycling program. The commercial solid waste and organic waste recycling program is required by state law and places requirements on businesses to implement solid waste and organic waste recycling/diversion. The County also participates in education, outreach and monitoring of businesses for compliance. At a future meeting the Board of Supervisors will consider revisions to the existing franchise hauler agreement in order that they comport with the revised ordinance and including, but not limited to, the addition of commercial solid waste and organic waste recycling programs.
