Amended Terms for State and Local Governments in the U.S.

Published December 28, 2016

The following terms will apply to each state and local government and government agency in the United States ("State/Local Government Entity") solely with respect to its acquisition and use of SSL/TLS digital certificates issued by ISRG for official government purposes ("Official Use"), and all other terms of the Let's Encrypt Subscriber Agreement ("Subscriber Agreement") will remain in effect:

1. Governing Law

Terms of the Subscriber Agreement relating to governing law will not apply to the State/Local Government Entity's Official Use.

2. Venue

Terms of the Subscriber Agreement relating to the venue or forum for disputes will not apply to the State/Local Government Entity's Official Use.

3. Indemnity

Terms of the Subscriber Agreement relating to indemnification will apply to the State/Local Government Entity only to the extent expressly permitted by its jurisdiction's laws.
