Dear Shangri-La Industries, LLC, 450 G Street, LP, and Step Up on Second Street, Inc.:

San Bernardino County (the "County") is writing to inform Step Up on Second Street, Inc., ("Step Up"), 450 G Street, LP and Shangri-La Industries, LLC, (collectively "SLA Entities") of the County's election to terminate that certain Homekey County Grant Agreement dated as of December 8, 2020, as amended pursuant to that certain First Amendment to Homekey County Grant Agreement dated as of February 9, 2021 (collectively, the "Grant Agreement").

On January 24, 2024, the County sent the attached further Notice of Default advising SLA Entities and Step Up of specific events of default and reserving the right to all rights, remedies and privileges under the Grant Agreement and applicable law, including, but not limited to, termination of the Agreement.

This letter serves as notice to the SLA Entities and Step Up of the County's election to immediately (a) revoke the County Grant as allowed under Section 6.2(a)(A) of the Grant Agreement and (b) terminate the Grant Agreement as allowed under Section 6.2(a)(C).

As of the date of this letter, the following defaults exist, remain uncured, and are continuing, each of which individually and collectively give the County the right to terminate the Grant Agreement effective immediately:

- A default under Section 6.1(a)(1) for failure to comply with the terms of that certain Standard Agreement, Award: 20-HK-00112 (the "Standard Agreement");
- A default under Section 6.1(a)(5) for failure to cure a default under financing for the project provided by Sunday Capital MP Loan Sales LLC with such default remaining uncured following the applicable notice and cure period;
- A default under Section 6.1(a)(6), resulting from the Superior Court of the State of California for the County of San Bernardino issuing an Order for Appointment of Receiver pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 564; Temporary Restraining Order, and Order to Show Cause on January 9, 2024 in Case No. CIVSB2320081; and
- A default under Section 6.1(a)(9), for failure to discharge or satisfy claims and numerous mechanics liens filed against the property within specified timeframes.
- Pursuant to Section 6.1(a)(12) failure to make the interim County-Assisted Units available for occupancy within the times and terms specified in the Standard Agreement.

The revocation of the County Grant and termination of the Grant Agreement are effective immediately. The rights, powers, and remedies afforded the County in the Grant Agreement are cumulative and the County reserves the right to seek any additional remedies at law or equity in addition to the remedies exercised under this Notice of Termination. Furthermore, all obligations of Step Up and the SLA Entities that survive termination of the Grant Agreement including, but not limited to, the duty to indemnify the County under Section 7.3 survive the termination of the Grant Agreement.
