### IT IS HEREBY AGRRED AS FOLLOWS:

### **AMENDMENT NO. 1**

This Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment") dated February 27, 2024, is made by and between FirstWatch Solutions, Inc. ("Contractor"), and Inland Counties Emergency Medical Services Agency ("ICEMA") and modifies the not-to-exceed amount and terms to agreement No. 22-987 executed between the parties as of October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022 ("Contract") with no change to the contract period of October 4, 2022, to October 3, 2027.

- 1. Effective February 27, 2024, ADD the "Additional Services Payment Schedule", incorporated and attached hereto, to the Contract existing payment schedule labeled as "Schedule A" in the Contract, as fully set forth therein.
- 2. Effective February 27, 2024, ADD the following as a new **Paragraph 19**, **CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE (SB 1439)**, and attach **Schedule D**, incorporated and attached herein, which shall read as follows:
  - **19.** Campaign Contribution Disclosure (SB 1439). Contractor has disclosed to the Inland Counties Emergency Medical Services Agency (ICEMA) using the "Schedule D" Campaign Contribution Disclosure Senate Bill 1439, whether it has made any campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Directors or other San Bernardino County elected officer [Sheriff, Assessor Recorder-Clerk, Auditor Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector and the District Attorney] within the earlier of: (1) the date of the submission of Contractor's proposal to the County, or (2) 12 months before the date this Contract was approved by the Board of Directors. Contractor acknowledges that under Government Code section 84308,

Contractor is prohibited from making campaign contributions of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Directors or other San Bernardino County elected officer for 12 months after ICEMA's consideration of the Contract.

In the event of a proposed amendment to this Contract, the Contractor will provide ICEMA a written statement disclosing any campaign contribution(s) of more than \$250 to any member of the Board of Directors or other San Bernardino County elected officer within the preceding 12 months of the date of the proposed amendment.

Campaign contributions include those made by any agent/person/entity on behalf of the Contractor or by a parent, subsidiary or otherwise related business entity of Contractor.

- 3. All other provisions and terms of the Contract shall remain the same and are hereby incorporated by reference. In the event of any conflict between the Contract and this Amendment, the terms and conditions of this Amendment shall control.
- 4. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same Amendment. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit an electronic signature of this Amendment (whether by facsimile, PDF or other email transmission), which signature shall be binding on the party whose name is contained therein. Each party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other party an original signed Amendment upon request.

NOTE 1: If Customer's data from CAD, ePCR, RMS (or other system(s)) is to be provided to FirstWatch via another Vendors Hosted Environment, fees payable to that Vendor (not reflected/included in this project quote) may be required. FirstWatch recommends that the Customer learn about options and costs associated with their Hosted Vendors approach & process - as fees will likely be required by Vendor to establish data feed/connection into FirstWatch.

If customer plans to switch Vendor for CAD, ePCR or RMS (other data system) from existing data interface feeding into FirstWatch, in addition to the Data Source Interface fee of \$7,500, additional work & fees will be required to convert specialized system enhancement modules such as FirstPass, OCU as well as Complex Triggers & Customized Reports, all of which can be Price upon Request (in advance). Data Mover sets up a process to automatically send data from FirstWatch to a customer. This includes data via Triggers, dashboards, workspace and alerts. ## **DEFINITIONS**

Agent: A third-party individual or firm who, for compensation, is representing a party or a participant in the matter submitted to the Board of Directors. If an agent is an employee or member of a third-party law, architectural, engineering or consulting firm, or a similar entity, both the entity and the individual are considered agents.

Otherwise related entity: An otherwise related entity is any for-profit organization/company which does not have a parent-subsidiary relationship but meets one of the following criteria:

(1) One business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other business entity;

(2) there is shared management and control between the entities; or

(3) a controlling owner (50% or greater interest as a shareholder or as a general partner) in one entity also is a controlling owner in the other entity.

For purposes of (2), "shared management and control" can be found when the same person or substantially the same persons own and manage the two entities; there are common or commingled funds or assets; the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share activities, resources, or personnel on a regular basis; or there is otherwise a regular and close working relationship between the entities.

<u>Parent-Subsidiary Relationship:</u> A parent-subsidiary relationship exists when one corporation has more than 50 percent of the voting power of another corporation.
