

## SCOPE OF WORK

### LOCAL AGENCY AGREES:

- A. **LOCAL AGENCY** shall furnish all labor, tools, materials, equipment and incidentals to control and eliminate noxious weeds under eradication causing depredations to State Highway areas in San Bernardino Local Agency.
- B. **LOCAL AGENCY** shall eliminate or control noxious weed species under eradication which could possibly be detected especially along State right-of-way I-15 at Cima Road, I-15/210, and State route 58 at/and west of Barstow. Yellow star thistle, white horse nettle, and Halogeton recurrently infest the State right-of-way.

Methods, materials and rates for control are as follows:

1. Yellow star thistle, Centaurea Solstitialis

Control: Telar XP, Cleantraxx, EsplAnade, Portfolio, Milestone VM, Rodeo, Crosshair as drift agent.

Application Rate: Telar XP 2 ounces per acre, Cleantraxx 4 pints per acre, EsplAnade 5 ounces per acre, Portfolio 10 ounces per acre, Milestone VM 3.5 ounces per acre, Rodeo 4 quarts per acre, Crosshair 4 ounces per acre.

Spray Volume: 30-50 gallons of water per acre.

2. Halogeton, Halogeton Glomeratus

Control: Telar XP, Cleantraxx, EsplAnade, Portfolio, Milestone VM, Rodeo, Crosshair as drift agent.

Application Rate: Telar XP 2 ounces per acre, Cleantraxx 4 pints per acre, EsplAnade 5 ounces per acre, Portfolio 10 ounces per acre, Milestone VM 3.5 ounces per acre, Rodeo 4 quarts per acre, Crosshair 4 ounces per acre.

Spray Volume: 30-50 gallons of water per acre.

3. White Horse Nettle, Solanum elaeagnifolium

Control: Telar XP, Cleantraxx, EsplAnade, Portfolio, Milestone VM, Rodeo, Crosshair as drift agent.

Application Rate: Telar XP 2 ounces per acre, Cleantraxx 4 pints per acre, EsplAnade 5 ounces per acre, Portfolio 10 ounces per acre, Milestone VM 3.5 ounces per Acre, Rodeo 4 quarts per acre, Crosshair 4 ounces per acre.

Spray Volume: 30-50 gallons of water per acre.

- C. **LOCAL AGENCY** shall apply herbicides to control weed and other unwanted vegetation on State Route 15 between postmile 0.0 and 52.0 and State Route 18 between postmile 87.9 and 99.0 in San Bernardino Local Agency. **CALTRANS** may supply all herbicides, adjuvants and spray pattern indicators. If the Local Agency of San Bernardino, Department of Agriculture applies their own pesticides, adjuvants or spray pattern indicators on State right-of-ways, **CALTRANS** will reimburse the **LOCAL AGENCY** at current market prices, plus applicable sales tax. The District Landscape Specialist shall make all recommendations. **LOCAL AGENCY** shall be on-call throughout the year as needed and shall respond within 48 hours. If traffic control is necessary, **CALTRANS** will provide traffic control.
- D. Discovery of Asbestos, Lead-Based Paint, or Other Hazardous Substances/Materials
1. If the **LOCAL AGENCY** discovers or suspects asbestos, lead-based paint, or other known hazardous substances/materials in the area affected by the Agreement, the **LOCAL AGENCY** shall **STOP WORK IMMEDIATELY**. The **LOCAL AGENCY** shall verbally notify the Caltrans Contract Manager of these findings immediately and confirm verbal notification in writing within 24 hours.
  2. Once notified, the **CALTRANS** Contract Manager will immediately request a site investigation and lab analysis report to determine the location(s) and percentage of asbestos material, lead-based paint or other hazardous substances/materials that are discovered or suspected to be present.
  3. Continuation of work shall not commence in that same area until the **LOCAL AGENCY** has been authorized to do so in writing, by the **CALTRANS** Contract Manager.
  4. Should it become necessary to cancel the work request, **LOCAL AGENCY** shall be compensated only for work in progress or actually completed to the **CALTRANS** Contract Manager's satisfaction. No payment shall be made for delay or lost profits anticipated for uncompleted work.
  5. Failure to notify the **CALTRANS** Contract Manager of the discovery of asbestos, lead-based paint or other hazardous substances/materials may result in immediate cancellation of the contract.

1. Cleantraxx \$19.99 per pint
2. EsplAnade \$11.56 per ounce
3. Milestone VM \$3.17 per ounce
4. Portfolio \$5.47 per ounce
5. Rodeo \$5.33 per quart
6. Telar XP \$13.73 per ounce
7. Crosshair \$0.35 per ounce

**There may be increases in the cost if pesticide prices go up during the term of the agreement.**
