Average Number of Patients Unvaccinated: 53 (68.4%)



County Testing Sites

- Our County testing sites continue to have high turnout (approximately 8,000 tests conducted daily)
 - 10 County sites
 - Arrowhead Regional Medical Center
 - 6 Public Health Clinics
- There are plans to extend hours of operations and increase the number of available tests per day





Antigen Test Kits at County Sites

- Effective January 3rd, all County testing sites began distributing Over-the-Counter (OTC) antigen testing kits
- These tests are self-administered with results in about 10 minutes



Antigen Testing Kits to Community Organizations

County has provided 116,861 over-the-counter antigen test kits to the people of San Bernardino County through partnerships with 295 agencies, including:

- <u>136</u> Community partners, non-profits, and other similar organizations
- 141 Local government agencies, including cities
- 18 Healthcare-related community service organizations
