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Hi Rob,

The recirculated MND for this project does not rely on the assumption that the project will serve existing and local warehouses. While this is highly likely the case, none of the technical studies rely on this assumption. The project was modeled using CalEEMod default values. The only non-default inputs are the mix of trucks/autos which was conservatively analyzed as 80% 4-axle and 20%-auto. With respect to the revised numbers on quantified projected air quality and GHG impacts, these changes are simply a result of the new CalEEMod model. Per your request, the model outputs are attached. Please let us know if you have any questions, concerns, or need any additional data.

Hi Heidi,

The recirculated MND for this project appears to still rely on the assumption that the project will only serve existing warehouses in the area and will not attract additional truck trips and logistics projects to the residential area where it is located. Do you plan to respond to the questions I posed below?

Also, I see that the quantified projected air quality and GHG impacts have changed somewhat from the prior MND—is that solely due to the switch to the newer version of CalEEMod, or did the County also change some of the input parameters? Release of the CalEEMod inputs/outputs would provide some useful transparency there.
