**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY
TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING OF VEHICLES/TOW-AWAY ZONE
ON COMMERCIAL STREET, BLOOMINGTON AREA**

On Tuesday February 8, 2022, on motion of Supervisor Baca, Jr., duly seconded by Supervisor Rowe and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works completed a traffic engineering investigation of Commercial Street (250350) in the Bloomington area; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to establish parking restrictions on County roads; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to establish a parking restriction on Commercial Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County as follows:

1. Due to conditions affecting the safety of the public utilizing Commercial Street (250350) in the Bloomington area, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to a traffic engineering investigation, deems it necessary and hereby resolves to:

Establish a "No Parking of Vehicles/Tow-Away Zone" pursuant to County Code Section 52.0132(a) along the south sides of Commercial Street (250350) between Cedar Place and Linden Avenue, for a distance of approximately 1,300 feet, in the Bloomington area.

2. The County Road Commissioner is hereby directed to perform such acts as are necessary to establish the Parking Restrictions above on Commercial Street (250350), in the Bloomington area.
