The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) received an increase in funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program (PHEP), Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI), CFDA # 93.069. CDPH is allocating an additional **\$8,086 to San Bernardino County's PHEP CRI funding**. San Bernardino County's total PHEP CRI allocation for FY 2021-22, including the increase is now **\$466,346**.

The funding period for CRI is July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022. Please submit a budget revision to include the CRI increase to [LHBTProg@cdph.ca.gov](mailto:LHBTProg@cdph.ca.gov) within 10 business days of this letter. You may begin spending the additional PHEP CRI funds once you have an approved budget revision.
