It is expected that the County will be reimbursed for this cost through an allocation of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding.

Chapter 6 of the San Bernardino County Code establishes the salaries and working conditions of the Extra-Help Appointment

The ordinance proposes to amend Section 13.0628 of the San Bernardino County Code, the terms and conditions of Extra Help Employment to provide the Director of Human Resources

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the authority, with the approval of the County's Chief Executive Officer, to provide Extra Help employees COVID-19 Premium Pay consistent with COVID-19 premium pay provided to the majority of the bargaining units.

The proposed amendments to County Code section 13.0628, provided for in the ordinance will become effective immediately upon the date of final passage.
