SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, _____, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors will consider adoption of a proposed ordinance relating to amendments to the County Charter and placing the proposed amendments to the County Charter on the ballot for the election on November 8, 2022.

Ordinance Summary

The proposed ordinance is to amend the charter of San Bernardino County for taxpayer protection and government reform and orders that such proposal be submitted to the qualified electors at the November 8, 2022 election. The proposed ordinance adopts amendments to the County Charter, which:

- Require the Board of Supervisors (Board) to approve any tax increase by a 4/5's vote of the Board and for the tax increase to be placed on the ballot at the next available statewide general election. This would include when the Board is acting as the governing body of Board-governed Special Districts, the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District or the San Bernardino County Flood Control District, but does not apply if the tax is proposed by property owners.
- Prevent the Board from voting to increase their salary.
- Revise the timing for the term limits.
