ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance of San Bernardino County, State of California, to amend Sections 52.0130, 53.0603, 53.0604, 53.0605, and 53.0606, to add Sections 53.0607 and 53.0608 to Chapter 6 of Division 3 of Title 5, and to add Section 16.0209 to Chapter 2 of Division 6 of Title 1, all of the San Bernardino County Code, relating to County Parking Lots and Electric Vehicle Charging Station Fees.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 52.0130 of the San Bernardino County Code is amended to read:

52.0130 Penalty.

- (a) Any person violating Except as otherwise provided, any person who violates any of the provisions of this Chapter Title or disobeyings any signs or markings installed pursuant thereto shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject to a civil penalty in an amount established by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to a schedule of parking penalties, unless the violation is cited as a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a remedyas provided by Chapter 2 of Division 1 of Title 1 of this Code (commencing with Section 11.0201).
- (b) Except as provided in California Vehicle Code section 40209 (as presently stated or amended in the future), the registered owner and driver, renter, or lessee of a motor vehicle cited for any violation of this Chapter related to

motor vehicle parking, shall be jointly liable for parking penalties imposed by the County, unless the registered owner can show, to the satisfaction of the San Bernardino County, that the vehicle was used without the owner's consent.

SECTION 2. Section 53.0603 of the San Bernardino County Code is amended to

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read:

53.0603 Control Devices and Equipment, and Marking of Stalls.

The Public and Support Services Group Projects and Facilities Management Department shall erect signs, devices, and other apparatus and provide marked spaces or stalls for the control of traffic and the parking of motor vehicles, including designated parking spaces for disabled persons and disabled veterans pursuant to in compliance with Vehicle Code section 22511.8.

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SECTION 3. Section 53.0604 of the San Bernardino County Code is amended to read:

53.0604 Parking Regulations.

The following regulations shall govern parking in County parking lots:

- (a) Motor vehicles shall be parked only in marked stalls or designated spaces.
- (b) Motor vVehicle operators must observe and comply with all traffic and parking control signs, devices, and directions.
- (c) A person assigned a particular parking lot or space shall park his or her motor vehicle only in such lot or space.
- (d) Appropriate parking permits must be properly displayed for parking in permitted spaces.
- (e) There shall be no parking in spaces or stalls in such manner as to obstruct the use of a parking lot or any other space by another person or to constitute a hazard to safety of person or property.
- (f) Only motor vehicles, which display a distinguishing license plate or placard, issued pursuant to <u>California</u> Vehicle Code <u>sections</u> <u>5007</u>, 22511.<u>5</u>5, <u>or or</u> 22511.<u>5</u>9 may park in parking spaces <u>or stalls</u> designated for disabled persons <u>and or disabled</u> veterans pursuant to Vehicle Code section 22511.8.
- (g) Only electric vehicles (EVs) and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEVs) may park at designated EV charging station parking stalls. Any vehicle that does not

require charging and EVs or PHEVs that are parked at, but not plugged into, the EV charging station are subject to penalties. "EV charging station parking stall" is defined as space in a parking lot or other location containing electric vehicle supply equipment that supplies electrical power for charging plug-in electric vehicles.

SECTION 4. Section 53.0605 of the San Bernardino County Code is amended to read:

53.0605 Speed Limit.

The maximum speed limit of all County parking lots or County-owned property shall be 15 miles per hour, however, lower speed limits may be posted by the Public and Support Services Group County and enforced accordingly.

SECTION 5. Section 53.0606 of the San Bernardino County Code is amended to read:

53.0606 Classification of Offenses and Penalties.

(a) ____Violation of any provisions of Section 53.0604 is an infraction, with violations of Subdivisions (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) punishable by a fine not to exceed \$25.00, and with violation of Subdivision (f) publishable by a fine not less than \$50.00. Violation of Section 53.0605 is a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed six months or both. Violation of any provisions of Section 53.0604 is a parking violation subject to a civil penalty, unless the violation is a misdemeanor. The penalties for violation of Section 53.0604 shall be as follows:

- (1) For Section 53.0604(a) the penalty amount shall be \$70.00.
- (2) For Section 53.0604(b) the penalty amount shall be \$80.00.
- (3) For Section 53.0604(c) the penalty amount shall be \$80.00.
- (4) For Section 53.0604(d) the penalty amount shall be \$100.00.
- (5) For Section 53.0604(e) the penalty amount shall be \$100.00.

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- (6) For Section 53.0604(f) the penalty amount shall be \$350.00.
- (7) For Section 53.0604(g) the penalty amount shall be \$200.00.
- (b) A late fee in the amount of 50% shall be added to the penalty amount when the penalty is not paid within 31 days of the date of the notice of violation. The date of payment is the day upon which the payment is received, or, when mailed, the date of the postmark.

SECTION 6. Section 53.0607 is added to Chapter 6 of Division 3 of Title 5 of the San Bernardino County Code, to read:

53.0607 Removal or Towing of Vehicles

- (a) Any vehicle in violation of this Chapter may be removed or towed away and stored. -at a garage and said rRemoval and storage costs shall be charged to and paid by the vehicle owner prior to release of the vehicle, in a manner and subject to the requirements of Chapter 10 of Division 11 of the Vehicle Code.
- (b) A vehicle shall not be removed or towed unless signs are posted giving notice of the possibility of removal or towing, and in a manner and subject to the requirements of Chapter 11 of Division 11 of the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 7. Section 53.0608 is added to Chapter 6 of Division 3 of Title 5 of the San Bernardino County Code, to read:

53.0608 Electric Vehicle Fees and Time Limits

- (a) The EV charging station monitors shall display the schedule of fees and time limits, if any, established by the Board of Supervisors. As a convenience to vehicle owners, the applicable fee, if any, may be displayed on the EV charging station application.
- (b) EV charging stations are intended for EVs and PHEVs that need to be charged. EVs and PHEVs not utilizing the service or parking for longer than is designated by signage are subject to citation as provided in Section 53.0606 and removal as provided

2	(c) Electric vehicle charging station user fees shall be as provided in Section
3	16.0209 of the San Bernardino County Code.
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5	SECTION 8. Effective October 27, 2022, Section 16.0209 is added to Chapter 2
6	of Division 6 of Title 1 of the San Bernardino County Code, to read:
7	16.0209 Electric Vehicle Charging Station User Fees
8	(a) Electric vehicle charging station user fees shall be \$0.31/kWH if vehicle is
9	charging (4 hour maximum charge time), plus \$.10/minute overstay fee (\$6.00/hour) for
10	the 5th and subsequent hours.
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12	SECTION 9. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from the date of
13	adoption.
