

As part of the Countywide Vision to provide sustainable infrastructure, the County is launching an Electric Vehicle Charging Initiative.

The goal is to increase the capacity and availability of electric vehicle charging stations throughout the County for use by members of the public and employees.



Electric Vehicle Charging Initiative

Pilot Project

- Located in Lot 7 at the County Government Center, at the corner of Third St. and Mountain View Ave.
- Completed in May 2022, pending activation
- Provides 5 dual head, Level 2 Chargers

Next Steps

- Approve charging station fees
- Activate pilot project charging stations once charging station fees are effective, on or around October 27, 2022



Overview of Ordinance

- Approves fees for the use of electric vehicle charging stations in County parking lots
- Updates the County Code to comply with State law related to parking violations
- Designates Projects and Facilities Management Department (PFMD) to install signage in County parking lots
- Establishes parking restrictions that only allows for electric and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles currently charging to park in designated electric vehicle charging station parking stalls
- Adds penalties for violations of restrictions
- Adds a section for removal or towing of a vehicle in violation of County Code requirements applicable to parking lots

Recommendations

- 1. Consider the proposed ordinance relating to County parking lots and electric vehicle charging station fees.
- 2. Make alterations, if necessary, to proposed ordinance.
- 3. Approve introduction of proposed ordinance.
 - An ordinance of San Bernardino County, State of California, to amend Sections 52.0130, 53.0603, 53.0604, 53.0605, and 53.0606, to add Sections 53.0607 and 53.0608 to Chapter 6 of Division 3 of Title 5, and to add Section 16.0209 to Chapter 2 of Division 6 of Title 1, all of the San Bernardino County Code, relating to County Parking Lots and Electric Vehicle Charging Station Fees.
- 4. Approve Capital Improvement Project No. 23-065, for the Countywide Electric Vehicle Charging Initiative Project in the amount of \$100,000, for the planning of electric vehicle charging stations at strategic locations throughout San Bernardino County.
- 5. Approve appropriation and revenue adjustments to fund the Capital Improvement Project No. 23-065 and authorize the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector to post the necessary adjustments, as detailed in the Financial Impact Section (Four votes required).
- 6. SCHEDULE ORDINANCE FOR FINAL ADOPTION ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2022, on the Consent Calendar.
