MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation

And

San Bernardino County Department of Public Health

This Agreement is to outline and define requirements pertaining to San Bernardino County Department of Public Health's (SBPH) pick-up, transport, and analysis of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation/California Correctional Health Care Services' (CDCR/CCHCS) wastewater samples. Such samples will undergo SARS-CoV-2 testing at SBPH's laboratory.

1. PURPOSE AND DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:

CDCR/CCHCS and SBPH will coordinate regularly scheduled wastewater sample pickup and specimen transport from CDCR/CCHCS' California Institution for Men (CIM) to the Public Health laboratory in San Bernardino County for SARS-CoV-2 testing.

The SBPH shall analyze SARS-CoV-2 viral concentrations in wastewater samples from CIM. The data shall be utilized by CDCR/CCHCS's Medical Leadership as well as CDCR/CCHCS's Public Health Deputy Medical Executive and their designees, local county health department staff, and the California Department of Public Health to facilitate informed decision-making about COVID-19 response.

The SBPH shall analyze samples and provide email notification and access to data to the designated contacts within 72 hours of receiving each sample.

Laboratory analysis shall be performed at the SBPH. Transportation and/or delivery shall be performed by other San Bernardino County staff. Sample collection shall be performed by staff at the CIM wastewater facility.

2. WORK LOCATION:

San Bernardino County staff designated to pick up samples from CIM and transport them to the Public Health laboratory will be based out of the San Bernardino County Public Health Department Administration Office at 351 N Mt. View Ave., San Bernardino, CA 92415.

3. TERM/PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The term of this MOU shall be October 25, 2022, (or upon approval, whichever is later), through October 31, 2023.

4. SBPH RESPONSIBILITIES

SBPH shall:

Sample Strategy

- i. Use untreated wastewater
- ii. Use composite samples
- iii. Pick-up 300 ml of sample
- B. Provide 300 ml or greater sample containers to facilitate sample collection by CIM staff.
- C. Pick-up and transport CIM's wastewater samples collected by CIM staff to the laboratory twice weekly. Samples shall be picked up at CIM's front gate between 8:00am and 10:00am.
- D. Not transport and process CIM wastewater samples if a representative from the CIM contacts the SBPH team to inform them that the composite sampler fails to collect a representative sample or if there are no suitable sample collection bottles.
- E. Test samples for SARS-CoV-2 using laboratory methods as described below.
- F. Follow CIM Chain of Custody. (Attachment 1)
- G. Communicate to CDCR/CCHCS as soon as possible if sample pick-up is not possible on a particular date or range of dates.
- H. Use Wastewater Surveillance Testing Methods
 - Sample concentration method: Magnet based concentration and RNA extraction.

- 2. RNA extraction method: MagMAX Wastewater Ultra Nucleic Acid Isolation Kits
- 3. RNA measurement Genetic Targets SARS-CoV-2 N1 and N2.
- 4. Laboratory Controls:
- 5. Matrix recovery control
- 6. Human fecal normalization
- 7. Quantitative measurement controls
- 8. Inhibition assessment
- 9. Negative controls
- I. If the testing method changes, the SBPH shall inform CDCR/CCHCS prior to submitting data produced by the new method.
- J. The SBPH's work hours shall be regular working hours for the laboratory and other county staff. No pick-ups shall occur at CIM on State holidays.
- K. Provide all services and supplies necessary to perform the required duties outlined herein.
- L. Designate a primary contact person to whom all communications may be addressed and who has the authority to act on all aspects of the services.

M. Debriefing and Reporting

- Communicate as needed by email to CDCR/CCHCS at <u>Wastewater@cdcr.ca.gov</u> other consultation with the State shall be scheduled as needed at a mutually convenient time as agreed upon by the SBPH and CDCR/CCHCS designated MOU contacts, not to exceed one (1) time per month.
- Provide data from wastewater testing to a secure dashboard for utilization by CDCR/CCHCS and CIM for COVID-19 monitoring and surveillance and to inform decision-making related to COVID-19.

5. CDCR/CCHCS RESPONSIBILITIES

CDCR/CCHCS shall:

A. Designate a person to whom all SBPH communication shall be addressed, and who has the authority to act on all aspects of the services. This person shall review the SOW and associated documents with the SBPH to ensure understanding of the responsibilities of both parties.

- B. Collect composite wastewater samples of untreated wastewater twice per week on agreed-upon days from a location with contributions from Facilities A, B and D.
- C. Initiate a CIM Chain of Custody document for each sample to closely track whose possession the sample is in prior to SBPH pick-up. (Attachment 1)
- D. Make the composite samples available for SBPH's pick-up at the CIM front gate between 8:00 and 10:00 AM.
- E. Inform SBPH as soon as possible if a sample is not available for pick up on a particular date or range of dates.
- F. Package the samples on ice to preserve the sample integrity.
- G. Ensure CIM wastewater facility staff perform the following:

6. TERM OF AGREEMENT

The term of this MOU shall be August 3, 2022 (or upon approval, whichever occurs later) through August 31, 2023.
