## Project Description

**Project Title:** Zone 4- Mojave River- Sale of Easements to Various; Portions of APN 0444-121-18, (W.O.# FCSUR22-00003)

**Project Location:** The subject parcel occurs within the Mojave River at the Bear Valley Bridge crossing in the Town of Apple Valley in San Bernardino County

**Project Description:** San Bernardino County Flood Control District (District) proposes granting approximately 1.83 acres of easements requested by the Town of Apple Valley for a portion of APN 0444-121-18, to be granted to the Town of Apple Valley, Southern California Edison (SCE) and San Bernardino County's Special Districts Service Area 64. The Town of Apple Valley's easements are for widening the Bear Valley Road Bridge and for a raised dirt pad on the northeasterly end of the bridge. SCE's easement for overhead transmission of power crossing the Mojave River along the northerly side of the bridge. Easement to the San Bernardino County's Special Districts Service Area 64 is for a water line being installed along the northerly side of the bridge. A separate CEQA document was provided for the Town of Apple Valley's Bear Valley Road Bridge Over the Mojave River Rehabilitation Project (project) SCH#2016111018.
