EXHIBIT A

AUTHORITY, PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF WORK

1. Authority

Pursuant to Item 2240-103-0001 of Section 2 of the Budget Act of 2019 as amended by Section 16 of Chapter 363 of the Statutes of 2019 (SB 109) (the "Statute"), the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") shall allocate to counties the designated funding for the support of housing navigators to help young adults 18 years and up to 21 years secure and maintain housing. This Standard Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into under the authority of, and in furtherance of the purposes of, the Statute.

2. Purpose

In accordance with the authority cited above, the Contractor was awarded Financial Assistance (the "Allocation Acceptance Form") from the Program (the "Grant"). The Allocation Acceptance Form, including all representations made by the Contractor made therein, are hereby incorporated in this Agreement by this reference. The Department agreed to make the Grant, based on the Statute and this Agreement.

The Department and the Contractor agree to enter into this Agreement in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein, subject to all the provisions of the applicable statutes and further subject to the state laws and requirements governing state contracts.

3. Scope of Work

The Contractor shall use all of this funding for the support of housing navigators to help young adults aged 18 years and up to 21 years secure and maintain housing, with priority given to young adults in the foster care system.

4. Monitoring and Reporting

The Contractor shall maintain books, records, documents, and other evidence that demonstrates the funding was used for the appropriate purposes, as laid out in the Scope of Work. These books, records, documents, and other evidence shall be made available for audit and inspection by the Department for a period of three years. A reporting form, provided by the Department, shall be submitted annually by July 31st. The report will capture data from the reporting period, which is from for the prior July 1st through June 30th, reporting period addressing the following:
