26	This Chapter is adopted pursuant to Section 34291 of the Health and Safety Code.
27	12.4702 Establishment.
28	There is hereby established a Housing Commission in San Bernardino County,

which may also be known as the "San Bernardino County Housing Commission" or the
"Housing Commission." The Housing Commission is an advisory body subordinate to the
Board of Governors of the Housing Authority of the County of San Bernardino. The
Housing Commission is not a legal entity separate from the Housing Authority of the
County of San Bernardino.

6 **12.4703** Membership.

7 The Housing Commission shall consist of seven members. Five members (non-8 tenant members) shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Board of Supervisors of the 9 County of San Bernardino (the "Board of Supervisors") upon nominations with one 10 nomination by each member (Supervisor) of the Board of Supervisors. If a Supervisor 11 fails to submit a nominee within a reasonable time after notice, the Board of Supervisors 12 may appoint any qualified person to fill the position. The other two members (tenant 13 members) shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors from among the tenants of the 14 Housing Authority.

15 12.4704 Qualifications.

Non-tenant members shall reside within San Bernardino County. Tenant members
shall be existing tenants lawfully residing in public housing of the Housing Authority. One
of the tenant members shall be over 62 years of age if the Housing Authority has tenants
of such age. If a tenant member ceases to be a tenant of public housing of the Housing
Authority, he or she shall be disqualified from serving and another tenant shall be
appointed by the Board of Supervisors to fill the unexpired term.

22 12.4705 Terms of Office.

The initial non-tenant members appointed by the Board of Supervisors upon
nomination by Supervisors representing the First, Third, and Fifth County of San
Bernardino Supervisorial Districts shall serve initial terms commencing on the date of
appointment and expiring on January 31, 2016. The initial non-tenant members
appointed by the Board of Supervisors upon nomination by Supervisors representing the
Second and Fourth County of San Bernardino Supervisorial Districts shall serve initial

terms commencing on the date of appointment and expiring on January 31, 2018.
Subsequent terms of the non-tenant members shall be four years and shall expire on
January 31 of the applicable year. One initial tenant member shall be designated to serve
a term commencing upon the date of appointment and expiring on January 31, 2015, and
one initial tenant member shall be designated to serve a term commencing upon the date
of appointment and expiring on January 31, 2016. Subsequent terms of tenant members
shall be two years and shall expire on January 31 of the applicable year.

8 12.4706 Method of Removal.

9 All Housing Commission members serve at the pleasure of the Board of
10 Supervisors. As such, they may be removed at any time, without cause, by a majority
11 vote of the Board of Supervisors.

12 12.4707 Resignation.

Any member of the Housing Commission may resign at any time by submitting a
written resignation to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Any such resignation shall
be effective upon submission, or upon such later date as is specified in the resignation if
such date is not more than 60 days after the date of submission.

17 **12.4708 Vacancies.**

18 If any member is absent from three consecutive meetings without such absence 19 being excused by the Housing Commission for good cause, the Housing Commission 20 shall promptly report such consecutive unexcused absences to the Board of Supervisors 21 who shall declare the position vacant. If a member becomes ineligible to serve on the 22 Housing Commission, the Board of Supervisors shall declare the position vacant. 23 Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term, in the manner specified above. A 24 vacancy shall exist upon the death, resignation, removal, or termination of residence 25 within the County or, in the case of a tenant member, termination of residence in Housing 26 Authority housing. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by the Board of 27 Supervisors.

28 12.4709 Powers of the Housing Commission.

1	The Housing Commission shall have those powers specifically set forth in Health
2	and Safety Code section 34292, and any successor statute thereto, and such other
3	powers as may be delegated to it by the Board of Supervisors as provided by law.
4	12.4710 Quorum.
5	Four members of the Housing Commission constitute a quorum for the purpose of
6	conducting its business and exercising its powers. Action may be taken by the Housing
7	Commission upon a vote of a majority of the members empowered to vote, unless in any
8	case the bylaws of the Housing Commission require a larger number.
9	12.4711 Officers.
10	The Housing Commission shall annually select a chairperson from its members
11	and such other officers as are provided for in its bylaws.
12	12.4712 Bylaws.
13	The bylaws on file with the Clerk of the Board and presented with this Chapter are
14	adopted as the initial bylaws of the Housing Commission. Thereafter, the bylaws of the
15	Housing Commission may only be amended by resolution with the approval of at least
16	four members of the Housing Commission at a regular or special meeting, and any
17	amendment shall not be inconsistent with the provisions of this Chapter, applicable Health
18	and Safety Code provisions, or enactments delegating powers to the Housing
19	Commission. No amendment may be considered unless at least 72 hours' written notice
20	thereof has been previously given to all members of the Housing Commission together
21	with a copy of the proposed amendment. Upon adoption or amendment by the Housing
22	Commission, such Bylaws shall be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for review. The
23	Board of Supervisors shall have the power to approve, disapprove, or modify said Bylaws,
24	as it deems necessary.
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26	SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from the date of
27	adoption.
