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Executive Summary (2500 max characters)	<p>The Arrowhead Regional Medical Center (ARMC) Primary Care Track is requesting funding for three existing Family Medicine positions and two expanded positions to support our effort to increase primary care physicians in the underserved regions of San Bernardino County of California. ARMC's mission is to train racially and ethnically diverse family medicine residents who are competent and culturally sensitive and who desire to practice in underserved areas after completing residency. San Bernardino County ranks in the bottom tier of counties in California for patient to primary care physician ratio and ranks in the lowest 15 for overall health outcomes. ARMC has set goals to develop expertise in our residents related to health disparities, advocacy and population health to improve population level outcomes in both of these metrics.</p> <p>Residents spend the majority of their residency training in San Bernardino County at ARMC including their sub-specialty/quaternary care experience Residents receive continuity clinic experience through three off ARMC Family Care Outpatient Clinics. Over 95% of our Family Medicine patient population have Medi-Cal or managed care Medi-Cal.</p> <p>In their time at ARMC residents are exceptionally trained in their ACGME mandatory sub-specialty rotations with the goal of being competent to practice Family Medicine in areas of physician shortages without tertiary care centers. Residents are exposed to low income patients in the inpatient and outpatient setting and learn about the difficulties many individuals face with complex care needs and very limited resources. At ARMC, our residents work in interdisciplinary teams to address the cultural, social or economic barriers our patients experience.</p> <p>The ARMC Family Medicine Residency Program participates in teaching medical students from Loma Linda University Health (LLUH), Western University, Saint Georges University, California University of Science and Medicine (CUSM), and University of California-Riverside Medical School (UCR). We will be graduating our 2020 class of 14 residents. The ARMC Family Medicine Residency Program will have a full complement of 46 residents in July 2020, and by 20201, 48. As of summer 2020, CUSM will be co-located on the ARMC Campus. CUSM has a focus on targeting low-income, minority individuals coming from the region to enroll as students.</p>
Describe the primary care pathways and/or pipeline activities in which your residents participate. (2500 max characters)	<p>There are three medical schools in close proximity to our residency program and we have developed ties to their pipeline programs. CUSM has a mission of targeting minority individuals coming from low-income communities and will be moving to the ARMC campus during the summer of 2020. ARMC residents perform outreach to medical students, high school, and middle school students. ARMC attends residency fairs at neighboring medical schools as well as work with Family Medicine student interest groups. Residents frequently support high school science programs and present at career fairs. ARMC residents are involved in encouraging high school students to pursue careers in healthcare. Residents assist high schools in getting students eligible for participation in athletics by providing sports physicals. Residents frequently attend middle school career fairs and provide medical support through their community health rotation.</p>

#### Step 5

What components of the training program are designed for medically underserved multi-cultural communities, lower socioeconomic neighborhoods, or rural communities? (2500 max characters)	<p>ARMC has set a goal that our residents will have more expertise than typical trainees in in the areas of health disparities, advocacy and population management. ARMC participates in Public Hospitals Redesign and Incentives in Medi-Cal (PRIME), which is part of the Medi-Cal wavier in California. As a result of participating in PRIME, ARMC is working to improve health care disparities metrics. These projects shape the hospitals and the clinics focuses to address certain metrics on health. Part of the process of developing this knowledge has been the establishment of small group learning sessions which occur monthly with the residents that are on site at ARMC and are devoted specifically to these topics. ARMC's faculty attend workshops on these topics to increase our own knowledge and skills in these areas. Residents receive information from the supervising physicians through core content and education activities.</p> <p>ARMC residents receive training in the culture of poverty, food insecurity, cultural competency, community resources, and other timely topics. Residents attend core content programming and education activities to learn more about serving medically underserved, multicultural, and lower socioeconomic neighborhoods. ARMC, which is owned and operated by the County of San Bernardino, is the county hospital serving the largest county in the contiguous United States, and San Bernardino has a vast geography of federally designated rural communities. ARMC is able to provide residents with exposure to serving rural communities by utilizing their mobile clinic to provide care to the underserved and rural areas of the High Desert.</p>
What challenges have you faced in meeting Song-Brown goals? Have you implemented any successful strategies? If so, do you believe any of these have been best practices? Describe the outcomes.	<p>It continues to be a challenge to recruit residents in the Family Medicine track in our geographic location and this has increased as the number of Family Medicine positions in Southern California has dramatically increased over the last three years. Family Medicine has become less competitive. Students have given feedback that they believe that they will receive better training if their entire residency is at a larger tertiary care institution. Some applicants might feel that a primary care track would keep them from being able to go into a sub-specialty if they decide on this while in residency, or have inadequate training for providing care for hospitalized patients.</p> <p>We have prioritized recruiting residents from under-represented minority groups and have had some success in this area but would like to see more under-represented minorities match into our program.</p>

Executive Summary (2500 max characters)

The Arrowhead Regional Medical Center (ARMC) Primary Care Track is requesting funding for five existing resident positions for Internal Medicine to support its effort to increase primary care physicians in the underserved regions of San Bernardino County of California. Our mission is to train racially and ethnically diverse internal medicine residents who are competent and culturally sensitive and who desire to practice in underserved areas after completing residency. San Bernardino County ranks in the bottom tier of counties in California for patient to primary care physician ratio and ranks in the lowest 15 for overall health outcomes. ARMC has set goals to develop expertise in our residents related to health disparities, advocacy and population health to improve population level outcomes in both of these metrics.

Internal Medicine residents spend complete their residency training in San Bernardino County at ARMC. The Continuity Clinic is onsite at ARMC with the majority of the patient population being Hispanic or Latino and over 81percent of the patients seen in the Continuity Clinic have Medi-Cal or managed care Medi-Cal.

In their time at ARMC residents are exceptionally trained in their ACGME mandatory sub-specialty rotations with the goal of being competent to practice Internal Medicine in areas of physician shortages without tertiary care centers. Residents are exposed to low income patients in the inpatient and outpatient setting and learn about the difficulties many individuals face with complex care needs and very limited resources. At ARMC, our residents work in interdisciplinary teams to address the cultural, social or economic barriers our patients experience.

The ARMC Internal Medicine Program participates in teaching medical students from Loma Linda University Health, Saint Georges University, Western University, California University of Science and Medicine (CUSM), and University of California-Riverside Medical School (UCR). We will be graduating our 2020 class of 12 residents and currently have a full complement of 36 residents. Beginning in July 2020, CUSM will be located on the ARMC campus. CUSM has a focus on targeting low-income, minority individuals coming from the region to enroll as students.

Describe the primary care pathways and/or pipeline activities in which your residents participate: (2500 max characters)

There are three medical schools in close proximity to our residency program and we have developed ties to their pipeline programs. The Loma Linda University Health (LLUH) is the closest, oldest, and largest program in the Inland Empire. Targeting high school students, the Institute for Community Partnerships at LLUH, provides a Summer Gateway program. This two-week summer program includes speakers and activities, with an optional third week where interested students can shadow health professionals in the workplace. UCR has a program for undergraduate students who are interested in medicine that spend a year as health coaches. CUSM has a mission of targeting minority individuals coming from low-income communities and will be moving to the ARMC campus during the summer of 2020.

Medical students rotate through many specialties at ARMC including primary care and get exposure to a high number of patients with health disparities.

ARMC residents are involved in encouraging high school students to pursue careers in healthcare. Residents participate in career days at local schools.

Step 5

What components of the training program are designed for medically underserved multi-cultural communities, lower socioeconomic neighborhoods, or rural communities? (2500 max characters)

ARMC has set a goal that our residents will have more expertise than typical trainees in in the areas of health disparities, advocacy and population management. ARMC participates in PRIME, which is part of the Medi-Cal waiver in California. As a result of participating in Public Hospital Redesign and Incentives in Medi-Cal (PRIME), ARMC is working to improve health care disparities metrics. These projects shape the hospitals and the clinics focuses to address certain metrics on health. Part of the process of developing this knowledge has been the establishment of small group learning sessions which occur monthly with the residents that are on site at ARMC and are devoted specifically to these topics. ARMC's faculty attend workshops on these topics to increase our own knowledge and skills in these areas. Residents receive information from the supervising physicians through core content and education activities.

ARMC residents receive training in the culture of poverty, food insecurity, cultural competency, community resources, and other timely topics. Residents attend core content programming and education activities to learn more about serving medically underserved, multicultural, and lower socioeconomic neighborhoods.

All of our residents do month long rotations where they are exposed to available community resources, needs and patients in a variety of settings.

What challenges have you faced in meeting Song-Brown goals? Have you implemented any successful strategies? If so, do you believe any of these have been best practices? Describe the outcomes.

It continues to be a challenge to recruit to an Internal Medicine track in our geographic location and this has increased as the number of Internal Medicine positions in Southern California has dramatically increased over the last three years. Internal Medicine has become less competitive. Students have given feedback that they believe that they will receive better training if their entire residency is at a larger tertiary care institution. Some applicants might feel that a primary care track would keep them from being able to go into a sub-specialty if they decide on this while in residency, or have inadequate training for providing care for hospitalized patients.

We have prioritized recruiting residents from under-represented minority groups and have had some success in this area but would like to see more under-represented minorities match into our program.
