#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

On March 10, 2020, in accordance with Government Code section 8630(a), the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors (Board) proclaimed the existence of a local emergency for the novel corona virus (COVID-19) affecting all cities/communities in San Bernardino County. The impacts from COVID-19 resulted in the need for the County to implement emergency protective measures.

Pursuant to Government Code section 8630(C), the Board shall review the need for continuing the local emergency until such emergency is terminated. Board approval of this recommendation would continue the local emergency for an additional period in accordance with Government Code section 8630(c).
