RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT MAKING CERTAIN RESPONSIBLE AGENCY FINDINGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT, DECLARING THAT THE CONVEYANCE OF 2,997 SQUARE FEET OF FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT PROPERTY (APN 0318-061-20) LOCATED IN THE CITY OF YUCAIPA IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST, THE INTEREST IN THE PROPERTY CONVEYED IS NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR THE USES AND PURPOSES OF THE DISTRICT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF THE LAND TO THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

On Tuesday June 23, 2020, on motion of Supervisor Gonzales, duly seconded by Supervisor Lovingood and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the County of San Bernardino Board of Supervisors, acting in its capacity as the governing board (Board) of the San Bernardino County Flood Control District (District), County of San Bernardino, State of California.

WHEREAS, the District owns fee title to an approximately 2,997 square foot parcel of land (APN 0318-061-20) ("Property") along the Wilson Creek Flood Control Channel at Avenue E in Yucaipa (City); and

WHEREAS, the District maintains the Wilson Creek Channel as part of its regional flood control system; and

WHEREAS, the City owns the parcel adjacent to the Property, APN 0318-061-27 designated for development of a community park to include a cultural resource center building, an amphitheater, a lake to be used for water recharge and recreational purposes, a children's playground, and other recreational amenities in the Dunlap area of the City (Project); and

WHEREAS, the City requested fee title to the Property to complete the site for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.) (CEQA), an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the Project was prepared and adopted by the City as the CEQA Lead Agency on July 3, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City, as CEQA Lead Agency, adopted the MND and the related Mitigation Monitoring Plan (MMP), and adopted written environmental findings; and

WHEREAS, the District, as the Responsible Agency, has verified that the City-adopted MND and MMP adequately analyze the potential environmental impacts and concurs in the analysis and conclusions set forth in said MND; and

WHEREAS, the District as a CEQA Responsible Agency must make certain findings pursuant to Section 15096(h) of the CEQA Guidelines in order to take action on the conveyance of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed the request from the City and determined that the conveyance of said Property is in the public interest and will not substantially conflict or interfere with flood protection in the region; and

WHEREAS, the Property is situated outside the physical boundaries of the Wilson Creek Channel, and the District's interest in the Property is no longer necessary to be retained for the specific uses and purposes of the District and is surplus to the needs of the District; and

WHEREAS, Epic Land Solutions, Inc. completed an appraisal of the Property on behalf of the City and determined the fair market value to be \$22,000, which was reviewed and revised to \$8,400 by the Real Estate Services Department to reflect the correct acreage to be conveyed; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to accept the fee simple title to the Property as well as all associated liability and maintenance responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the District will convey the fee simple title of the Property to the City in accordance with the San Bernardino County Flood Control Act, California Water Code Appendix, Chapter 43, Section 43-6, and County Policy 12-17, and Government Code Section 25526.5 upon payment by the City of \$8,400 to the District

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the San Bernardino County Flood Control District hereby finds, determines, and orders as follows:

- 1. The above recitals constitute findings of the Board and are incorporated herein.
- 2. The MND and MMP for the Project are, by this reference, incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
- 3. The District hereby certifies that, acting as the Responsible Agency for the Project pursuant to Section 15096 of the CEQA Guidelines, it has independently reviewed and analyzed the MND, together with the MMP, and other information in the record and has considered the information contained therein, prior to acting upon or approving the portion of the Project before the Board for consideration.
- 4. Based on this review, the District finds that, as to those potential environmental impacts within the District's powers and authorities as Responsible Agency, that the MND contains a complete, objective, and accurate reporting of the potential impacts and represents the independent judgment and analysis of the San Bernardino County Flood Control District as Responsible Agency.
- 5. The District, in its capacity as Responsible Agency, considered the MND together with the MMP prepared for the Project, and independently finds that the MND is adequate for use by the District to take action on the conveyance of the Property. Furthermore, the District finds that no significant adverse impacts will occur as a result of the conveyance and that no further CEQA analysis is required.
- 6. The District designates the District's offices at 825 East Third Street, Room 123, San Bernardino, California 92415-0835 as the custodian of documents and records of proceedings on which this decision is based.
- 7. The District declares that the conveyance of fee simple title to the Property is in the public interest and is no longer necessary for the uses and purposes of the District and it is authorized to convey said fee simple title to the City of Yucaipa in accordance with the San Bernardino County Flood Control Act, California Water Code Appendix, Chapter 43, Section 43-6 and County Policy 12-17, and Government Code Section 25526.5 upon payment by the City of \$8,400 to the District.
