**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO TO
ESTABLISH A MID-BLOCK CROSSWALK ON STANFIELD CUTOFF, BIG BEAR AREA**

On Tuesday June 23, 2020, on motion of Supervisor Gonzales, duly seconded by Supervisor Lovingood and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

Due to conditions affecting the welfare of the public utilizing Stanfield Cutoff in the Big Bear area, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to an engineering and traffic survey, deems it necessary to:

1. Establish a mid-block crosswalk on Stanfield Cutoff (771150) approximately 1,300 feet southeast of North Shore Drive (HWY 38) pursuant to section 52.0124(a) of the County Code.
2. Direct the County Road Commissioner to perform such acts as are necessary to implement the terms of this resolution.
