- Uniform Handling (mandatory trash collection) was established in 2004 for property owners in the Valley and majority of the Mountain areas to assist the County in meeting waste diversion requirements in AB 939.
- Established as a cost effective, standardized way to provide refuse collection service, reduce illegal dumping and enhance recycling programs.
