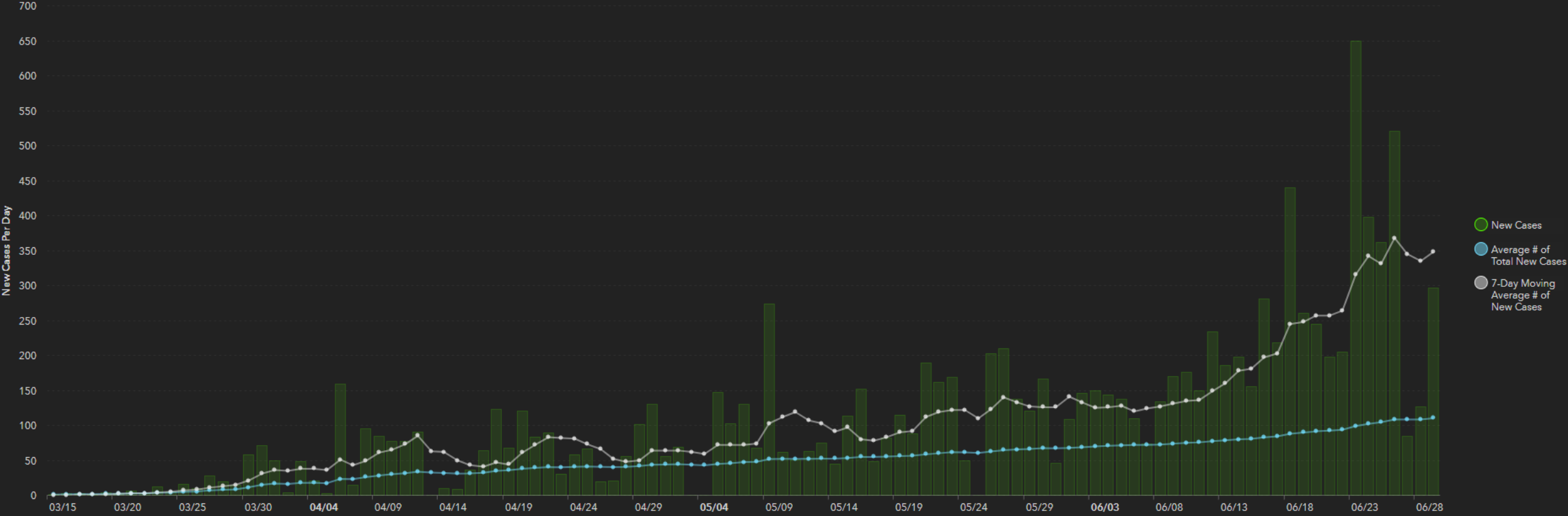

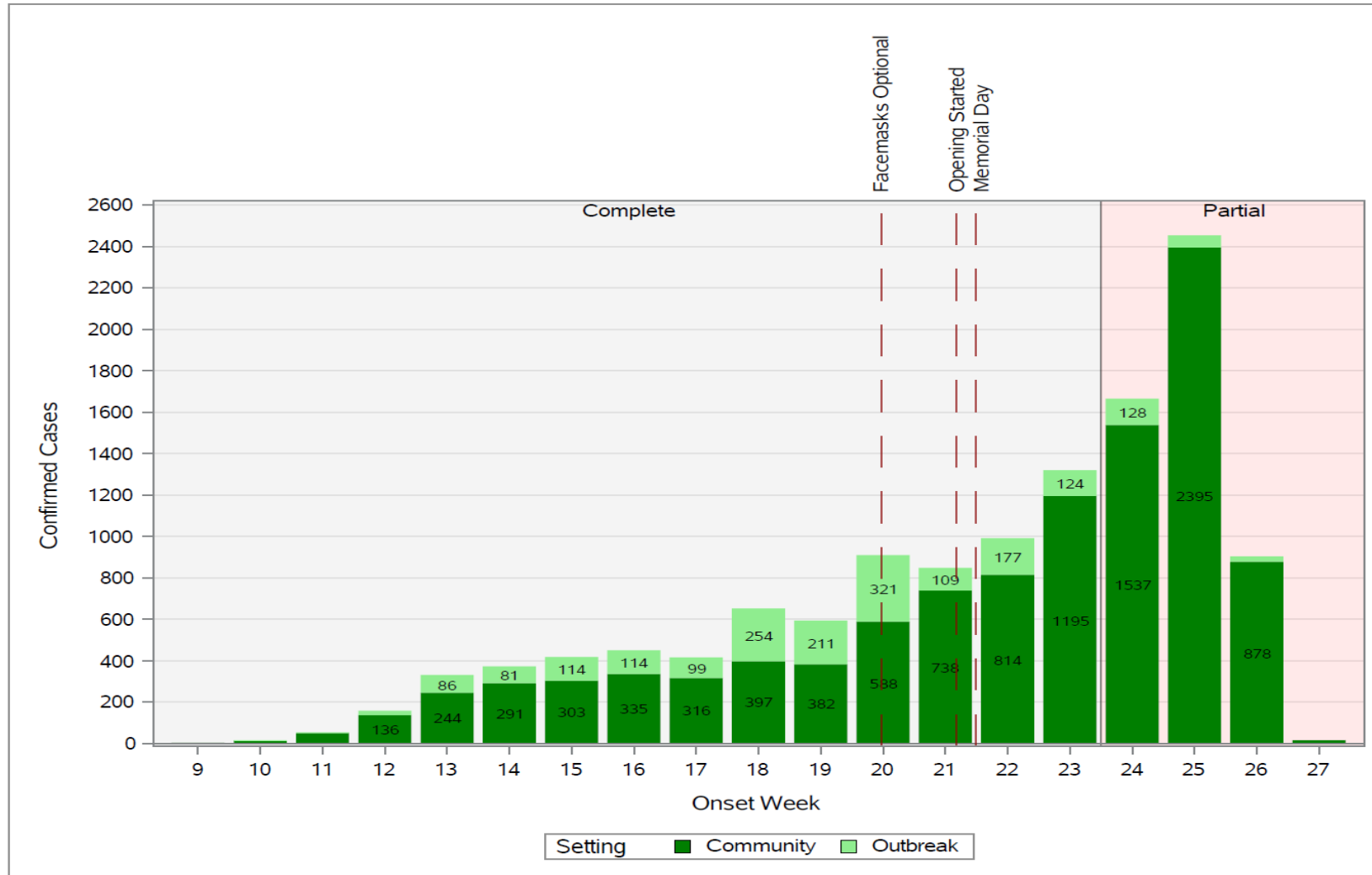
## COVID-19 PCR Tests Per Day

# Criteria For Flagging A County For Elevated Disease Transmission

County	Avg # tests per day (per 100,000 population) (7 day average with a 7 day lag)	Case rate per 100,000 (14 days)	Testing positivity (%) (7 day average with a 7 day lag)	% Change in 3-day avg COVID+ hospitalized patients	% ICU beds currently available	% Ventilators currently available
San Bernardino	160.9	145.2	11.2	10.3	✓	✓

1. Case rate (per 100,000) >100 **OR** Case rate (per 100,000) >25 **AND** testing positivity >8.0%
2. >10% increase in the average number of confirmed COVID-19 patients hospitalized
3. <20% of staffed ICU beds are available **OR** <25% of ventilators are available

# Positivity Rate – State Requirement is <8%
