Total Vaccines Received	639,575

Skilled Nursing Facilities Remain a Priority

- Surveys completed to determine number vaccinated SNF residents and employees
- Survey results indicated vaccinations for SNF's are still in high demand
- Public Health is allocating a portion of the vaccination supply to these facilities
- Vaccinating newly admitted patients and prioritizing staff needing COVID-19 vaccines
- Mobile vaccine clinic for facilities most in need
- Facilities have been served in the following locations: Rialto, Upland, San Bernardino, Ontario, Victorville, Yucaipa, and Highland

Protecting Our County Through COVID-19

Ready to Accelerate Pace of Vaccinations

- As eligibility expands, we are poised to vaccinate as many residents as possible
- With 16+ eligibility on the horizon, the task force is preparing plans to quicken the pace of vaccinations
- Plans include increasing vaccination locations in the Healthy Places Index (HPI) lower quartiles.



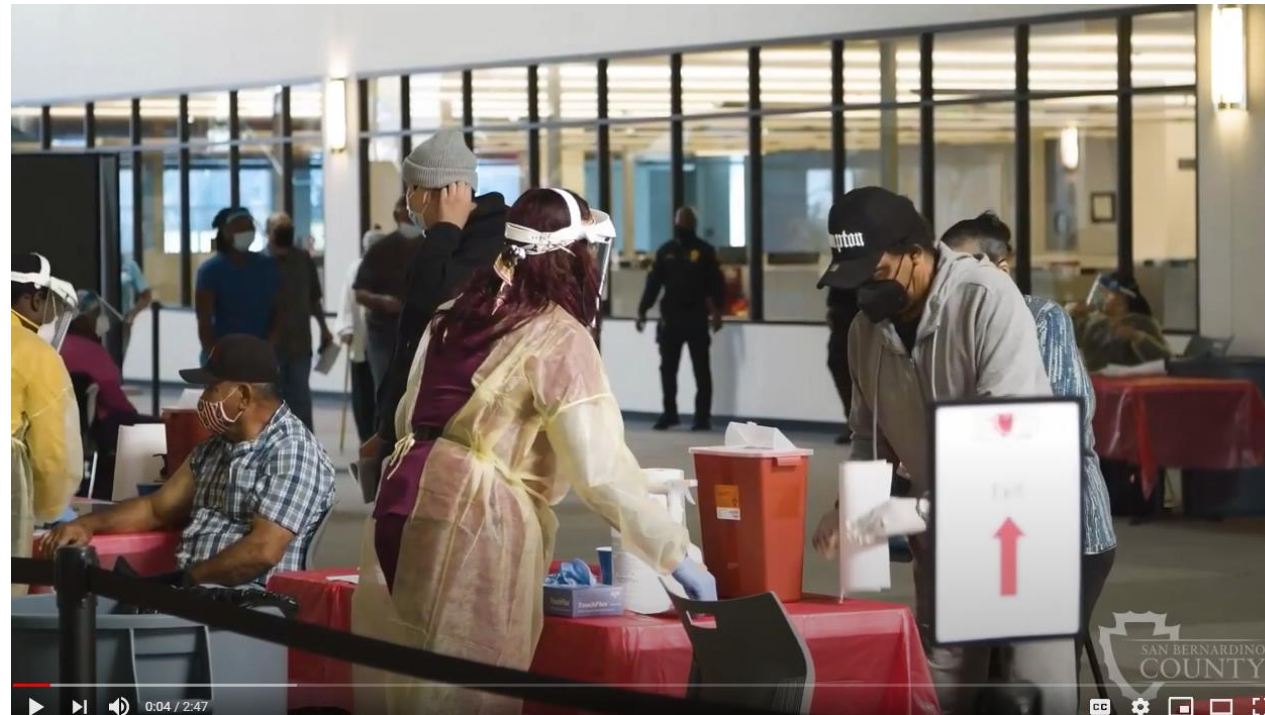
