Vaccinating San Bernardino County

Total Cases: 290,886 * Adjusted Case Rate 2.9/100,000 * Overall Positivity: 1.7% * Equity Positivity: 1.8%
Testing Volume: 287.6 tests/100,000

- **How Far to Yellow Tier?** Our overall positivity needs to be below 2 and the equity positivity needs to stay below 2.3 for at least two weeks.
- **Vaccines now available without appointments.** (Second doses are pre-scheduled for convenience.)
- **Help with appointments is still available –** Call the hotline 909-387-3911.

Total Vaccines Received	966,555
Total Vaccines Distributed	871,985
