IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

It is hereby agreed to amend Contract No. 20-969, effective July 1, 2021, as follows:

SECTION V. FISCAL PROVISIONS

Paragraphs A. and C. are amended, and Paragraph I is added, to read as follows:

- A. The maximum amount of reimbursement under this Contract shall not exceed \$1,222,130, and shall be subject to availability of funds to the County. The consideration to be paid to Contractor, as provided herein, shall be in full payment for all Contractor's services and expenses incurred in the performance hereof, including travel and per diem.
- C. Contractor shall submit a monthly invoice to HS Contracts by the 15th calendar day of the month following the month of service. The monthly invoice shall consist of the actual invoice and the completed reports as specified in Section II, Paragraph D. Invoices shall be issued with corresponding SAP Contract and/or Purchase Order number stated on the invoice, and shall be processed with a new sixty (60) day payment term following approval by County.

I. Contractor may continue to invoice for any unused funds remaining from the initial budget period of October 2020 – June 2021. Funds remaining from the initial budget period will rollover per the approved budget line items.

SECTION VIII. TERM

Amend Section to read as follows:

This Contract is effective as of October 1, 2020, and is extended from its original expiration date of June 30, 2021, to expire on March 31, 2022, but may be terminated earlier in accordance with provisions of Section IX of the Contract. The Contract term may be extended for one (1) additional one-year period contingent on future funding and by mutual agreement of the parties.
