Vaccinating San Bernardino County

Total Cases: 293,117 * Adjusted Case Rate 1.5/100,000 * Overall Positivity: 1.0% * Equity Positivity: 1.2%
Testing Volume: 225.1 tests/100,000

Total Doses Administered to Residents of San Bernardino County	1,544,240
Eligible county residents (ages 12+) who have been vaccinated	48.5%
Eligible county residents who have been fully vaccinated	39.5%

 - Apple Valley, Bloomington, Big Bear, Fontana, Hesperia, Joshua Tree, Ontario, Rancho Cucamonga, Rialto, San Bernardino, Victorville, Yucaipa, Chino, Upland, Muscoy and other locations as needed.
 - In addition to the mobile sites, there are dozens of hospitals, health centers, clinics and pharmacies that are offering vaccines.
