- Uniform Handling (mandatory trash collection) was established in 2004 for property owners in the Valley and majority of the Mountain areas to assist the County in meeting waste diversion requirements in AB 939.
- Established as a cost effective, standardized way to provide refuse collection service, reduce illegal dumping and enhance recycling programs.

Delinquent Accounts

- Delinquent Accounts = those which did not file for an exemption, fee waiver, or pay their bill in a timely manner and have now gone into delinquency status.
