BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Calico House Restaurant (Restaurant) is leased to a concessionaire who operates the facility. The Restaurant has deteriorating flooring throughout the back of the house and kitchen areas, which could create a potential health and safety risk for the Restaurant employees. An evaluation by the San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services Department on June 1, 2021 resulted in the requirement that these floors be repaired prior to the Restaurant's reopening. The project scope for this building includes the removal of existing flooring, disposal of existing flooring material, repair of subflooring and replacement of flooring to code for a food preparation establishment.

The recommended Project aligns with the County and Chief Executive Officer Goals and Objectives to Improve County Government Operations, Operate in a Fiscally-Responsible and Business-Like Manner, Provide for the Safety, Health and Social Service Needs of County, and Pursue County Goals and Objectives by Working with Other Agencies by allowing the Department to address these safety concerns.
