Project Title: Macy Street Sidewalk, Muscoy Area Project

Project Location: Macy Street, north of Darby Street and south of Blake Street in the community of Muscoy, San Bernardino County, CA. (See Location Map)

Project Description: The Proposed Project entails removing the existing asphalt concrete berm and a small portion of the adjacent asphalt and replacing with new concrete curb; gutter; adjacent asphalt surface; driveways; and sidewalks along an approximately 390-foot length of the west side of Macy Street. The maximum width of work area is approximately 15-feet and approximately 10-inches in depth for excavation. Equipment to be used may include but not limited to: 1 tractor, 1 loader, and 1 backhoe.
