RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY TO ESTABLISH A MULTI-WAY STOP AT CACTUS AVENUE AND SANTA ANA AVENUE IN THE BLOOMINGTON AREA

On Tuesday September 14, 2021, on motion of Supervisor Baca, Jr., duly seconded by Supervisor Rowe and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works completed a traffic engineering investigation of Cactus Avenue and Santa Ana Avenue in the Bloomington area.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to establish a multi-way stop on County roads; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to establish a multi-way stop at the intersection of Cactus Avenue and Santa Ana Avenue in the Bloomington area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County as follows:

Due to conditions affecting the safety of the public utilizing the intersection of Cactus Avenue (197400) and Santa Ana Avenue (730800) in the Bloomington area, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to a traffic engineering investigation deems it necessary and hereby resolves to:

- 1. Establish a multi-way stop at the intersection of Cactus Avenue and Santa Ana Avenue in the Bloomington area; and
- 2. Direct the County Road Commissioner to perform such acts as are necessary to implement the terms of the resolution.
