## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON CACTUS AVENUE IN THE BLOOMINGTON AREA

On Tuesday September 14, 2021, on motion of Supervisor Baca, Jr., duly seconded by Supervisor Rowe and carried, the following resolution is adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, State of California.

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works completed a traffic engineering investigation of Cactus Avenue, in the Bloomington area; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Supervisors is authorized to establish parking restrictions on County roads; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to establish a parking restriction on Cactus Avenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County as follows:

1. Due to conditions affecting the health and safety of the public utilizing Cactus Avenue (197400) in the Bloomington area, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to a traffic engineering investigation deems it necessary and hereby resolves to:

Establish a "No Stopping, Standing, or Parking" zone, pursuant to County Code Section 52.0118(a), along the west side of Cactus Avenue, from Manilla Street to 362 feet north of Ash Street, a distance of 717 feet, in Bloomington area.

2. The County Road Commissioner is hereby directed to perform such acts as are necessary to establish the Parking Restrictions above on Cactus Avenue (197400) in the Bloomington area.
