## WITNESSETH:

IN THAT CERTAIN **Contract No. 20-490** by and between San Bernardino County, a political subdivision of the State of California, and Contractor for Non-Residential Drug Court Services, which Contract first became effective July 1, 2020, the following changes are hereby made and agreed to, effective October 26, 2021:

- I. ADDENDUM II, PARAGRAPH D <u>Specific Responsibilities</u>, paragraph 1. Program Description, b. Program Description Adult Court Program, 2) Program Specific Responsibilities, sub-paragraph b), and Paragraph 1. Program Description, b. Program Description Adult Court Program, 3) Program Scope of Services, d) Adult Drug Court Program Phase Length, are hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 1. b. 2). b). The Adult Drug Court Treatment Program shall be a minimum of 12 months in length but shall not exceed 18 months.

1. b. 3). d). Adult Drug Court Program Services shall total no less than 12 months but no more than 18 months.

Phase I: Minimum of fourteen (14) weeks.

Phase II: Minimum of thirteen (13) weeks.

Phase III: Minimum of thirteen (13) weeks.

Phase IV: Minimum of twelve (12) weeks, up to a maximum of thirty-two (32) weeks, with an option/referral to complete their treatment program by engaging in Recovery Services even if the court has terminated probation.
