## Project Description

**Project Title:** Zone 1- Lower Deer Creek Channel- Portion of APN 0218-141-07 – Outgoing Public Road and Utilities Easement

**Project Location:** The subject portion of APN 0218-141-07 lies east and adjacent to Archibald Avenue and straddles both the north and south side of Lower Deer Creek Channel (1-501-11) in the City of Ontario, San Bernardino County (see Location Map).

**Project Description:** The San Bernardino County Flood Control District (District) is proposing to grant to the City of Ontario (City) an easement of a portion of parcel APN 0218-141-07 for street and bridge improvements proposed for Archibald Avenue by the City as part of the Countryside Specific Plan development. The location of the easement is on the east side of Archibald Avenue where the street crosses over Lower Deer Creek Channel (see Location Map). The easement portion is approximately 0.10 acres in size.
