## **Question and Answer:**

Q: Since multiple contractors will be awarded a JOC (e.g., 5 contractors for the General Building JOC, 3 contractors for the General Engineering JOC, etc.), what method(s) will the County use to select a contractor for performance of each job order under each JOC? Will the individual job orders also be competitively bid among the five GBJOC16 JOC contractors? Or will the County select one of the five contractors using another method (e.g., rotational basis, past performance record, etc.) for each job order?

A: The individual job orders are not competitively bid. Initially, work is assigned as evenly as possible across the contracts given varying project budget amounts. However, performance issues may affect the amount of work assigned to a contractor. There is no minimum amount of work guaranteed on these contracts.
