CSA 70 Havasu Lake – Prop 218 Public Hearing

- District was established on April 1, 1990
- Provides refuse collection and disposal services for property owners in Havasu Lake, California
- Community refuse locations and onsite service for commercial businesses
- Last rate increase was established FY 2011/12
- Increasing hauler costs
- Increasing operation and administrative costs
- Two Community Clean up days

CSA 70 Havasu Lake – Prop 218 Public Hearing

- August 2021
 - Community notified of town hall meeting
 - Town hall provided. Recording posted to District's website
- September 2021
 - Proposition 218 notices sent to property owners
- November 2021
 - Public hearing to adopt new Resolution, establishing appropriate rates for a five (5) years
 - Approve Contract with Allied Waste Transportation, Inc. dba Republic Services of Bullhead City to provide refuse collection and disposal service





CSA 70 Havasu Lake - Prop 218 Public Hearing

Staff Recommendation to the Board:

- Adopt resolution repealing Resolution No. 2011-114 and authorizing new refuse collection service charges effective January 6, 2022.
- Approve contract with Allied Waste Transportation, Inc. dba Republic Services for 5 years to provide refuse collection and disposal services in a total amount not to exceed \$388,759.04.
