## FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this item will not result in the use of Discretionary General Funding (Net County Cost). Fees for the Big Bear Valley Recreation and Park District (District) are estimated to generate approximately \$1.7 million in revenue for 2020-21. These fees along with property tax revenue are the District's primary source of funding. Appropriation and revenue related to these fees will be included in the District's 2020-21 recommended budget.
