BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Inland Empire Resource Conservation District (District) has informed the County of the vacancy on the District Board of Directors. Approval of this item will direct the Clerk of the Board to post a notice of vacancy for one position on the Board of Directors for the District and set Tuesday, December 21, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. as the deadline to submit applications for this position of Director. These recommended actions are necessary to comply with the California Public Resources Code.

The District has accepted the resignation of Paul C. Williams, a member of the District's Board of Directors, effective November 1, 2021. As provided in Section 9316 of the California Public Resources Code, in case of a vacancy in the office of director appointed pursuant to Section 9314, the vacancy shall be filled, as provided in Section 9314, by appointment for the unexpired term by the Board of Supervisors of the principal county. Mr. Williams was appointed pursuant to Section 9314 on December 15, 2020.

An applicant for director of a Resource Conservation District must be a registered voter in the State of California, and (1) reside within the district and either own real property in the district or have served for two years or more as an associate director providing advisory or other assistance to the district directors, or (2) be a designated agent of a resident landowner within the district.
