# REPORT/RECOMMENDATION TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY AND RECORD OF ACTION

#### **SUBJECT**

Grant Award Amendment for Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction Program

#### **RECOMMENDATION(S)**

- 1. Approve Grant Award Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. 21-761 with the California Insurance Commissioner to accept an additional \$50,094, increasing the grant award from \$437,669 to a total award amount of \$487,763, to fund the Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction Program from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.
- 2. Adopt Resolution, as required by the California Department of Insurance authorizing the District Attorney to execute and submit all documents in relation to the acceptance of the Grant Award Amendment, on behalf of the County, subject to review by County Counsel.
- 3. Authorize the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer/Tax Collector to post the necessary budget adjustments of \$50,094, as detailed in the Financial Impact Section, in the District Attorney's 2021-22 budget (Four votes required).
- 4. Direct the District Attorney to transmit all Grant Award Amendment documents to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors within 30 days of execution.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The California Department of Insurance (CDI) administers the Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction Program (Program) under the direction of the State Insurance Commissioner and pursuant to California Insurance Code Section 1874.8. The CDI distributes grant funds to offices of the district attorney statewide for the purpose of investigating and prosecuting organized automobile fraud. The acceptance of this grant amendment aligns with the goal of providing for the safety of County residents by assisting the Department in the investigation and prosecution of automobile fraud crimes. The Department has been receiving grant funds for this purpose for the past 17 years.

On October 26, 2021 (Item No. 35), the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved Grant Award Agreement No. 21-761 with the California Insurance Commissioner accepting \$437,669 for the Program. The grant is used to partially fund one Deputy District Attorney IV and one District Attorney Senior Investigator assigned to the Program. On January 6, 2022, the Department was notified of additional funding in the amount of \$50,094, which will partially fund the salaries and benefits of the existing two staff assigned to this grant. The grant award letter references a return date of February 4, 2022, which has been extended to February 11, 2022 by the Insurance Commissioner's office in order to obtain all necessary approvals and signatures.

The State of California, Department of Insurance requires a resolution from the Board authorizing the District Attorney to execute and submit all documents in relation to the acceptance of the Grant Award Amendment.
